

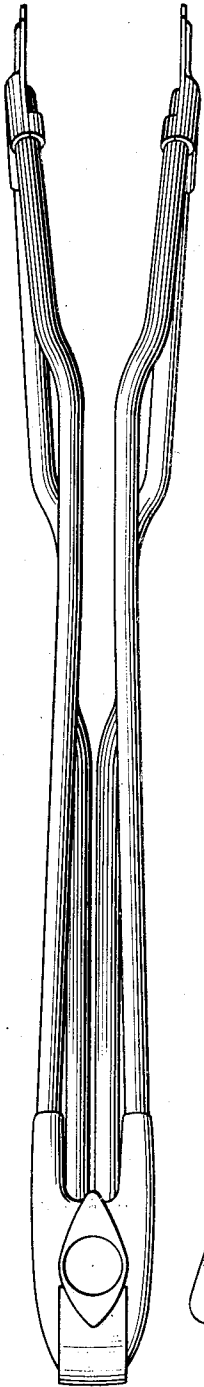

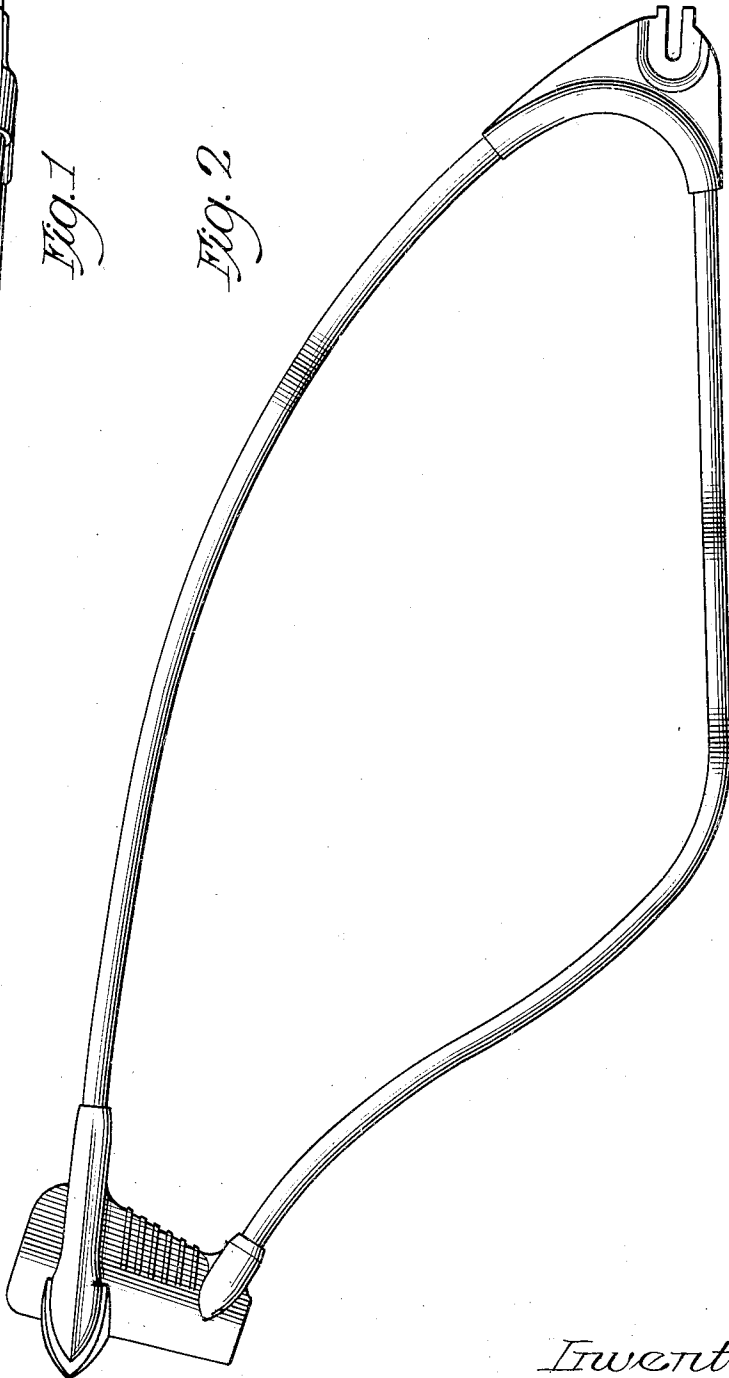

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, John R. Morgan, a citizen of the Republic of Guatemala, residing in Oak Park, in the county of Cook and State of Illinois, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Bicycle Frame, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.
