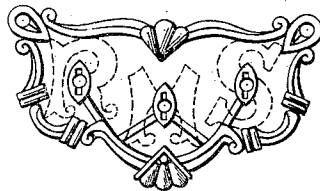

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Felix P. Kinsley, a citizen of the United States, residing at the city of St. Louis, State of Missouri, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Framed Monogram Unit for Necktie Holders or the like, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.
