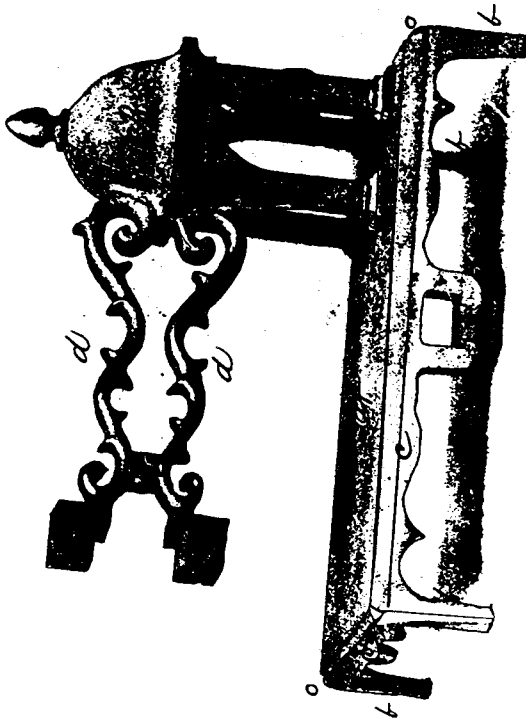

Be it known that we, Charles A. Shaw and James B. Clark, of Biddeford, in the County of York, and State of Maine, have invented or produced a new and original design for a sewing machine arm; and we hereby declare that the following is a full, clear and exact description of the same, reference being had to the accompanying drawings forming part of the same, in which drawings, A, is the bed piece or body of the machine. B is a Gothic four legged standard or upright having a double ornamental scroll-work arm d, d. fully shown in the drawings.

We claim the ornamental design for a sewing machine arm; d, d. as shown and described.
