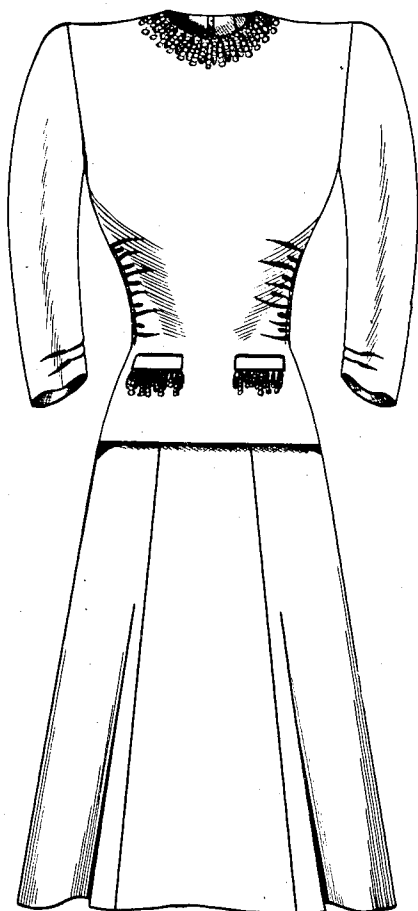
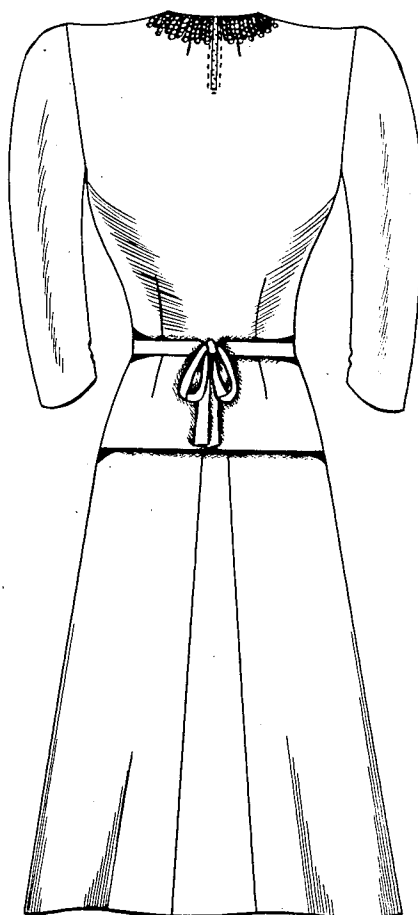

DESIGN FOR A DRESS

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Julia Richards, a citizen of the United States, residing in Brooklyn, New York city, in the county of Kings and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Dress, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.
