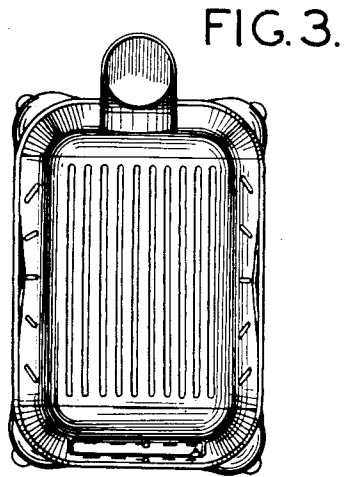
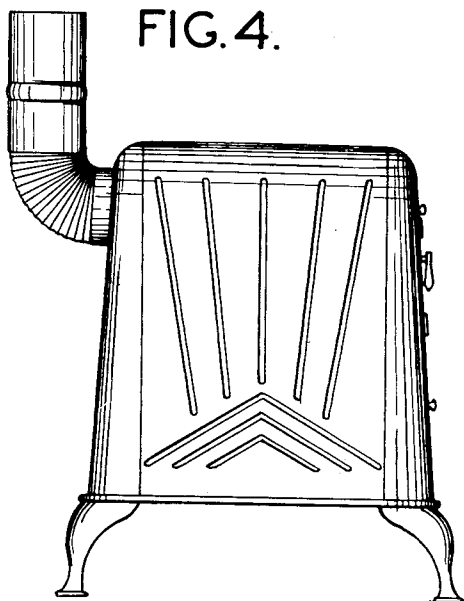
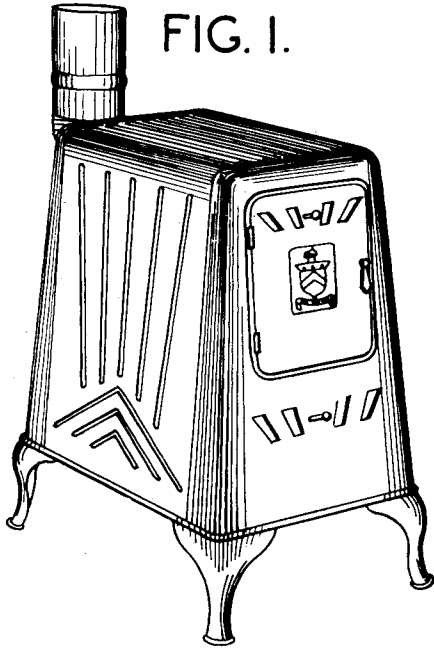

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that we, STANLEY F. JACKES and FREDERICK W. PAVEY, citizens of the United States and residents of University City, St. Louis County, Missouri, and Sunset Terrace, St. Louis County, Missouri, respectively, have invented a new, original and ornamental Design for a Stove, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing forming part hereof, in which Fig. 1 is a perspective view of the stove showing our new design; Fig.

2 a front elevation; Fig. 3 a plan; and Fig. 4 a side elevation.
