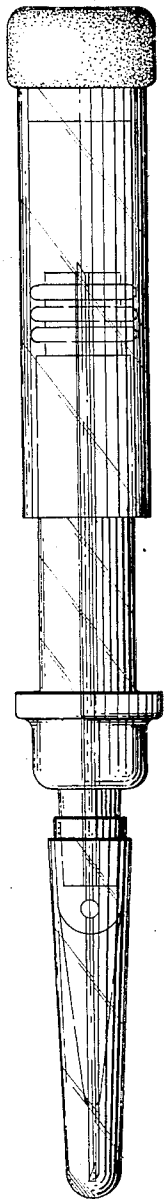

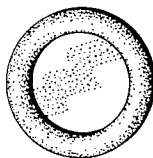

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Arthur E. Smith, a citizen of the United States, residing at Los Angeles, in the county of Los Angeles and State of California, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Disposable Syringe, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

In the accompanying drawing:

Fig. 1 is a side elevation of a disposable syringe, showing my new design;

Fig. 2 is a front view of the disposable syringe, and

Fig. 3 is a rear view of the disposable syringe.
