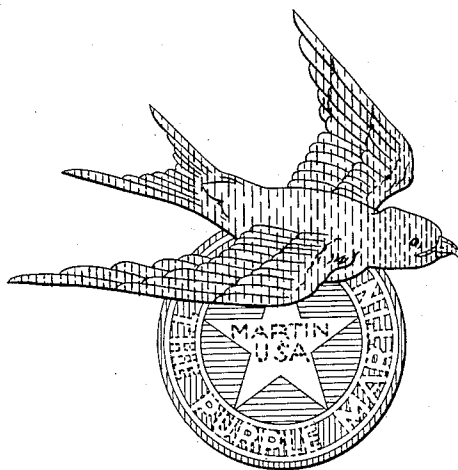
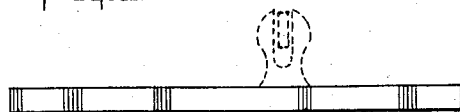

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Glenn L. Martin, a citizen of the United States and a resident of the city of Baltimore and State of Maryland, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Lapel Pin or the like, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.
