
(57) **CLAIM**

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top lateral perspective view of a shoe showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a top view of the shoe, thereof;

 FIG. 4 is a medial side view of the shoe, thereof;
 FIG. 5 is a rear view of the shoe, thereof;
 FIG. 6 is a front view of the shoe, thereof; and,
 FIG. 7 is a bottom view of the shoe, thereof.
 In FIGS. 1-7, the broken lines on the upper of the shoe, including any laces, tongue or logos, form no part of the claimed design. Also, the broken lines showing a shoe outsole, including any logos, form no part of the claimed design.














