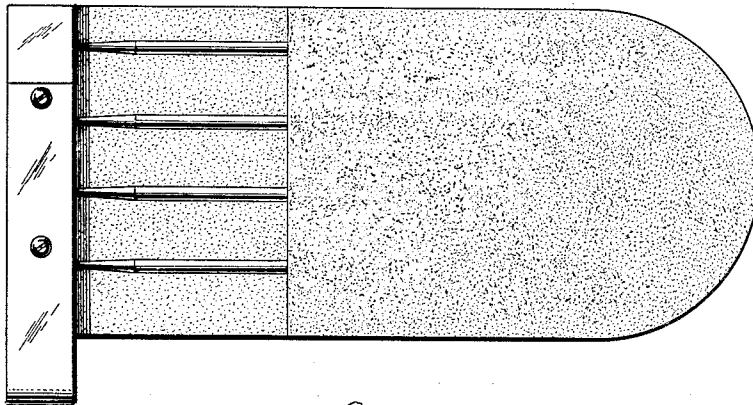

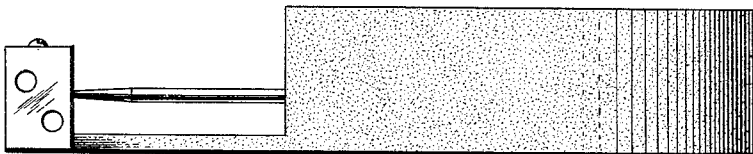
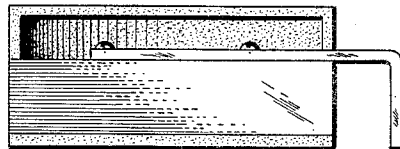

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Joseph Frank Bishop, a citizen of the United States of America, a resident of Newark, county of Essex, State of New Jersey, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Door Signal Device, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part hereof.

Figure 1 is a top plan view of a door signal device showing my new design;

Figure 2 is a side elevational view thereof; and

Figure 3 is an end elevational view thereof.
