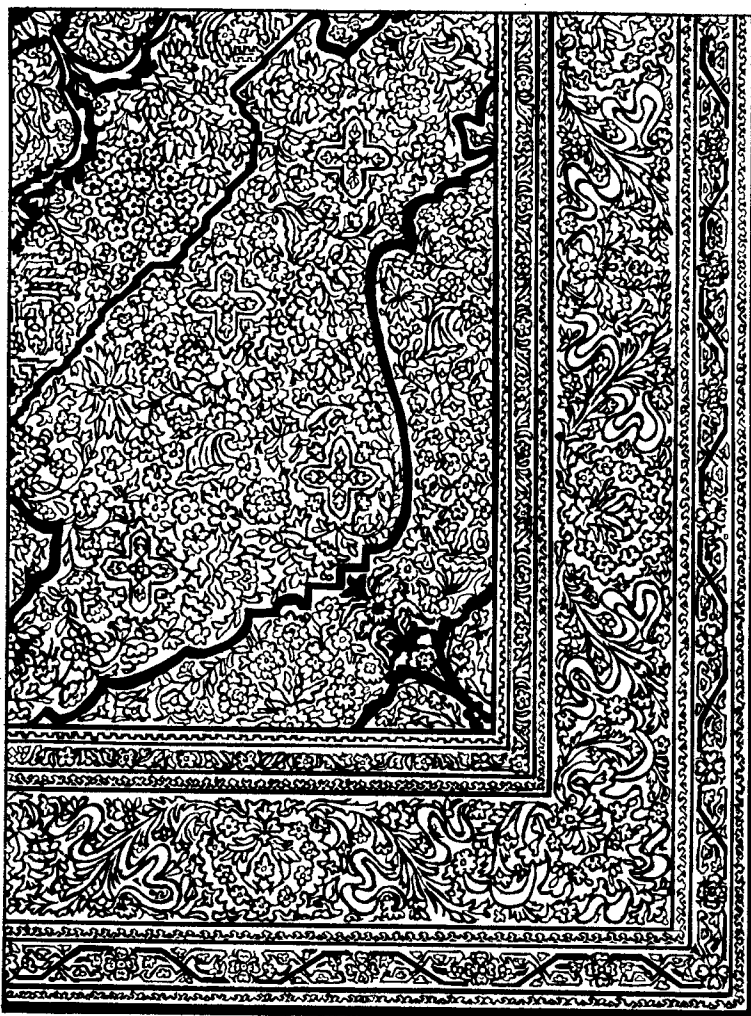

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, ERNEST W.
