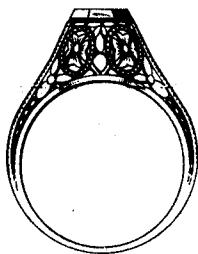

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, DAVID SHIMAN, a citizen of the United States, and a resident of the city, county, and State of New York, have invented a certain new, original, and ornamental Design for a Finger Ring, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

In the drawing:

Fig. 1 is a top plan view of a finger ring showing the new design;

Fig. 2 is a side view of the ring taken from either side in Fig. 1;

Fig. 3 is an edgewise view of the ring.
