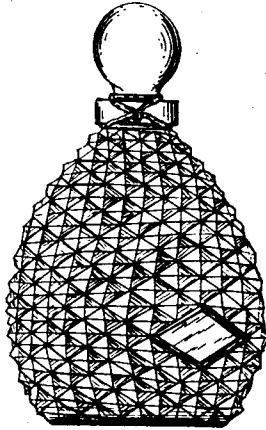
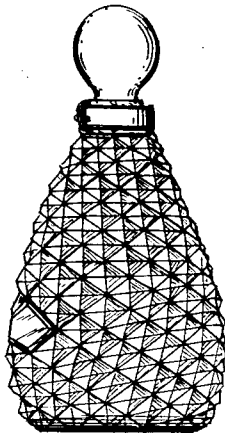

DESIGN FOR A BOTTLE.

Application filed May 4, 1926. Serial No. 17,563. Term of patent $3\frac{1}{2}$ years.

To all whom it may concern:
