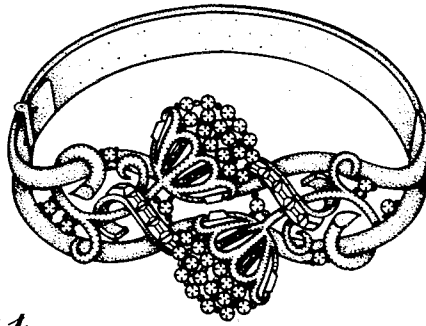

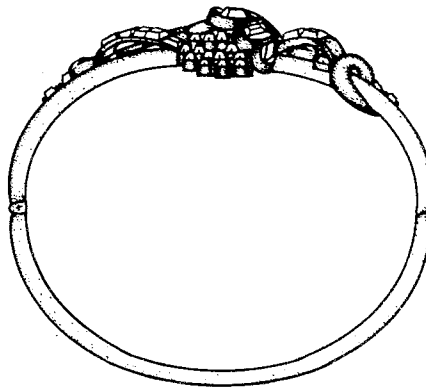

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Alfred Philippe, a citizen of the United States of America, residing in Scarsdale, county of Westchester, and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Bracelet or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.
