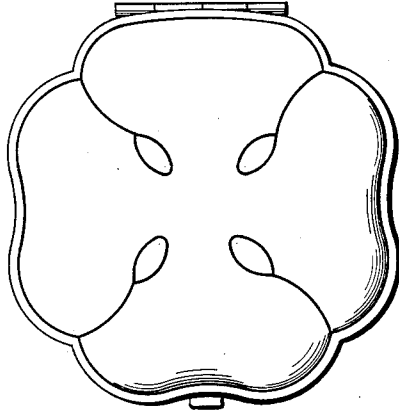
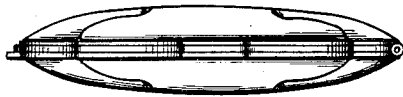

Be it known that I, Harry L.
