


To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Otto H. Samuelson, a citizen of the United States, residing at Indianapolis, in the county of Marion and State of Indiana, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Bottle, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.
