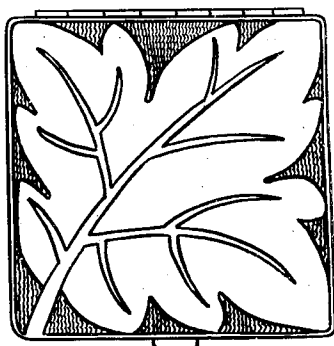

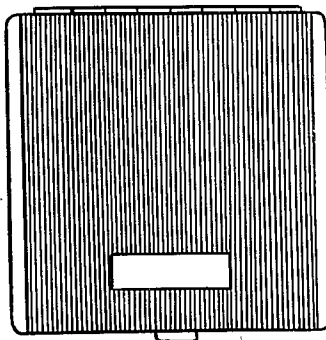

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Florence N. Lewis, a citizen of the United States of America, residing in New York city, county of New York, and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Compact, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof, wherein,

Figure 1 is a top plan view of a compact showing my new design.

Figure 2 is a bottom plan view thereof; and Figure 3 is a front edge elevational view thereof.

The characteristic feature of the design resides in the surface ornamentation on top of the compact illustrated.
