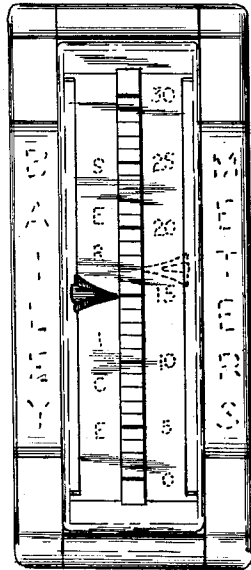

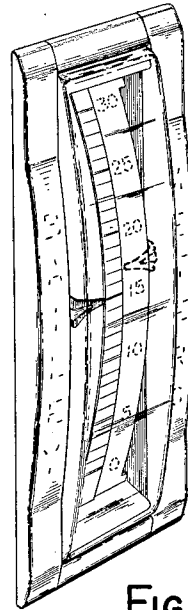

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that we, Paul S. Dickey, a citizen of the United States, residing at East Cleveland, in the county of Cuyahoga, State of Ohio, and Kenneth A. Wood, a citizen of the United States, residing at South Euclid, in the county of Cuyahoga, State of Ohio, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for an Indicating Instrument Face, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part hereof.

Fig. 1 is a front elevational view of an indicating instrument face showing our new design.

Fig. 2 is a front perspective view thereof.

The essential features of the design reside in the solid line portions.
