DESIGN FOR A VASE OR SIMILAR ARTICLE

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Carl Schmitz, a citizen of the United States of America and a resident of New York, in the county of New York and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Vase or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

Figure 1 is a perspective view of a vase or

similar article showing my new design, the ornamentation appearing on one surface being shown. Figure 2 is a perspective view showing the ornamentation appearing on the remainder of the surface.
