FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view;

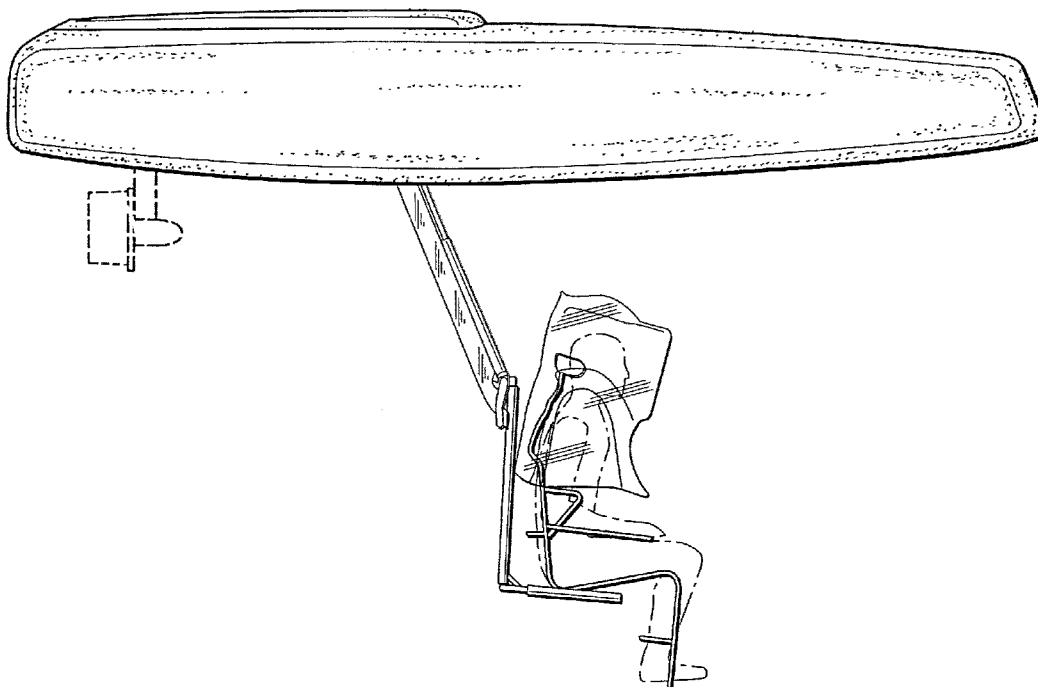
FIG. 6 is a top plan view;

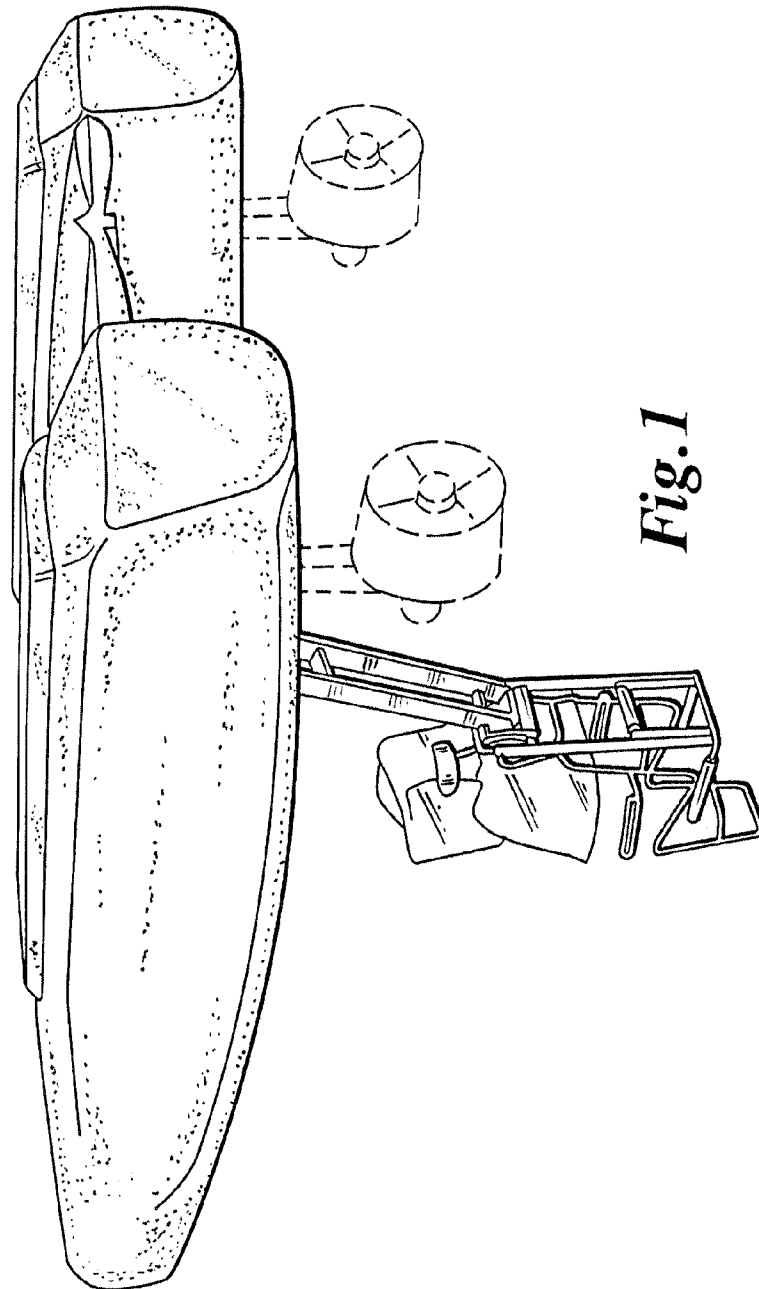
FIG. 7 is a right elevational view with the chair down; and,

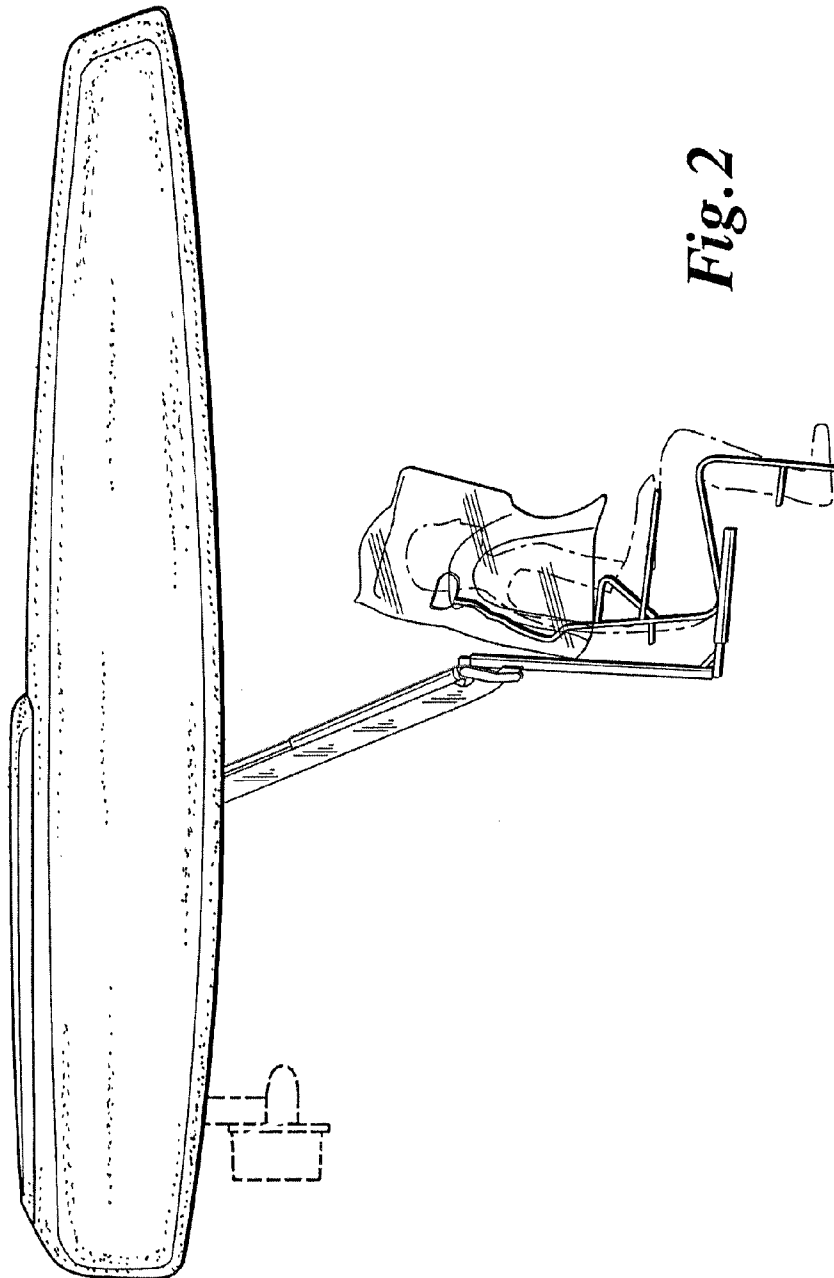

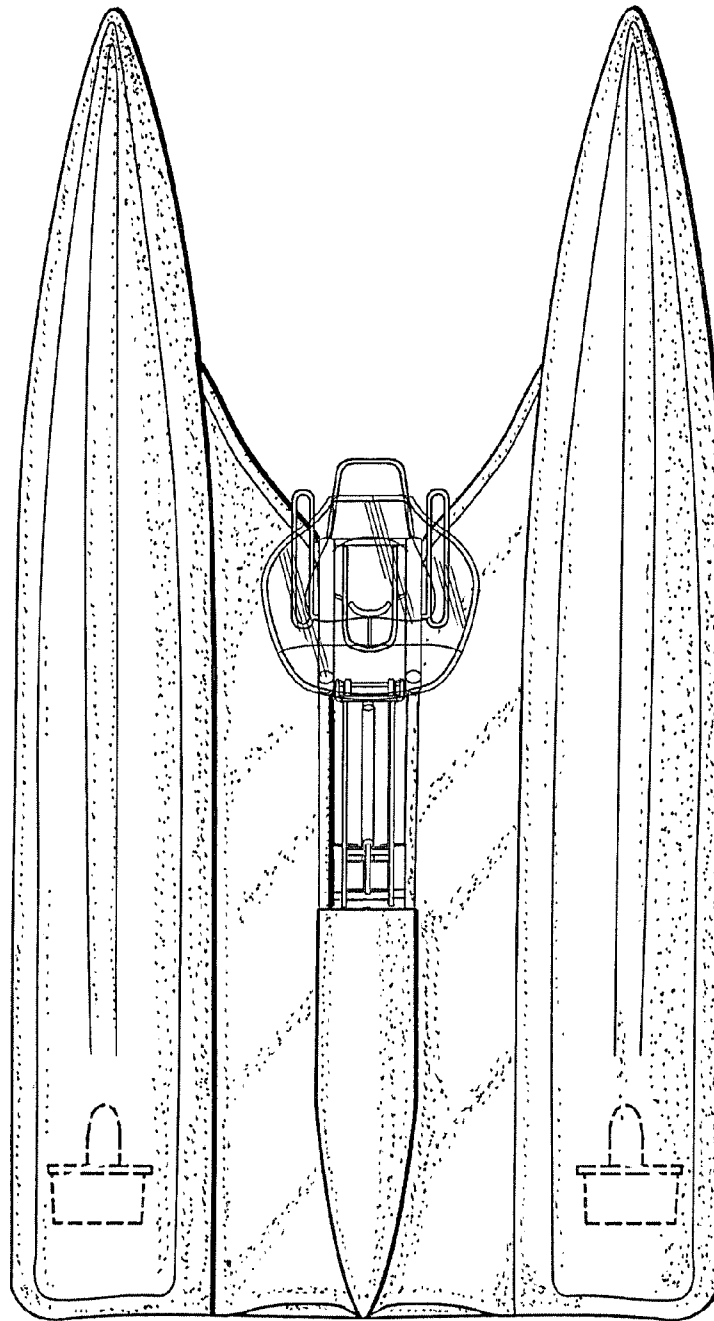

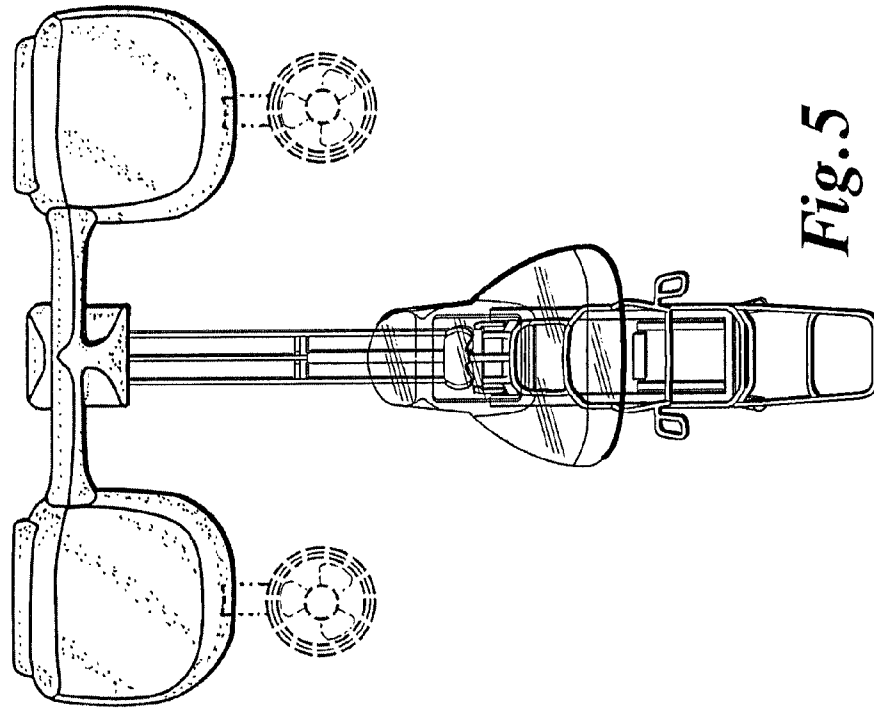

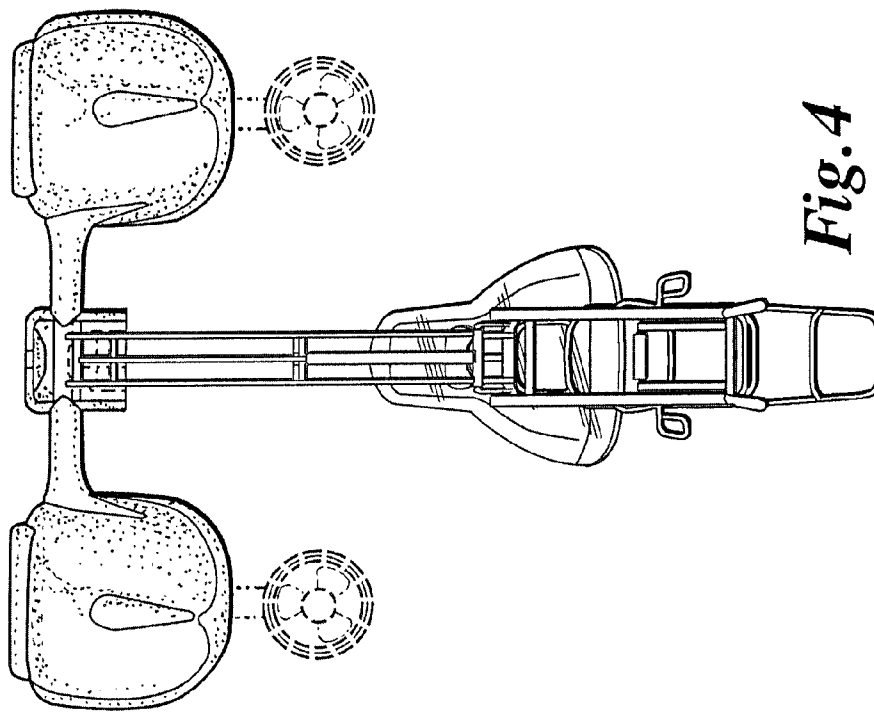

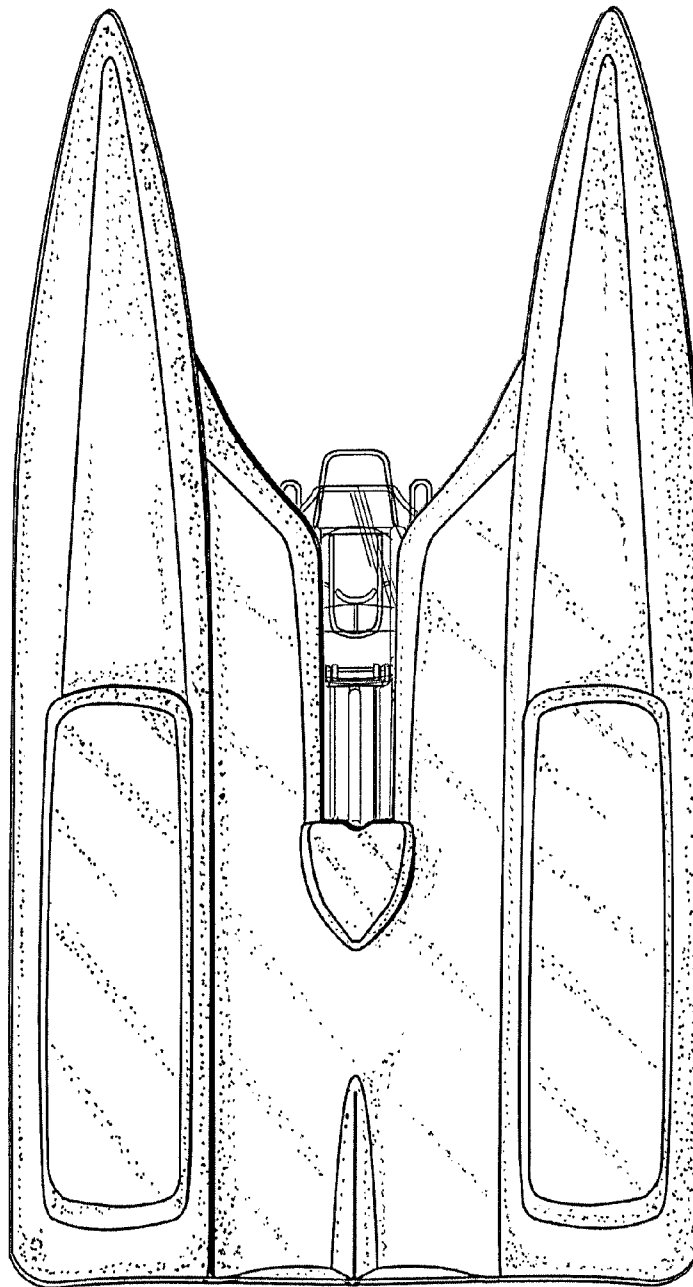

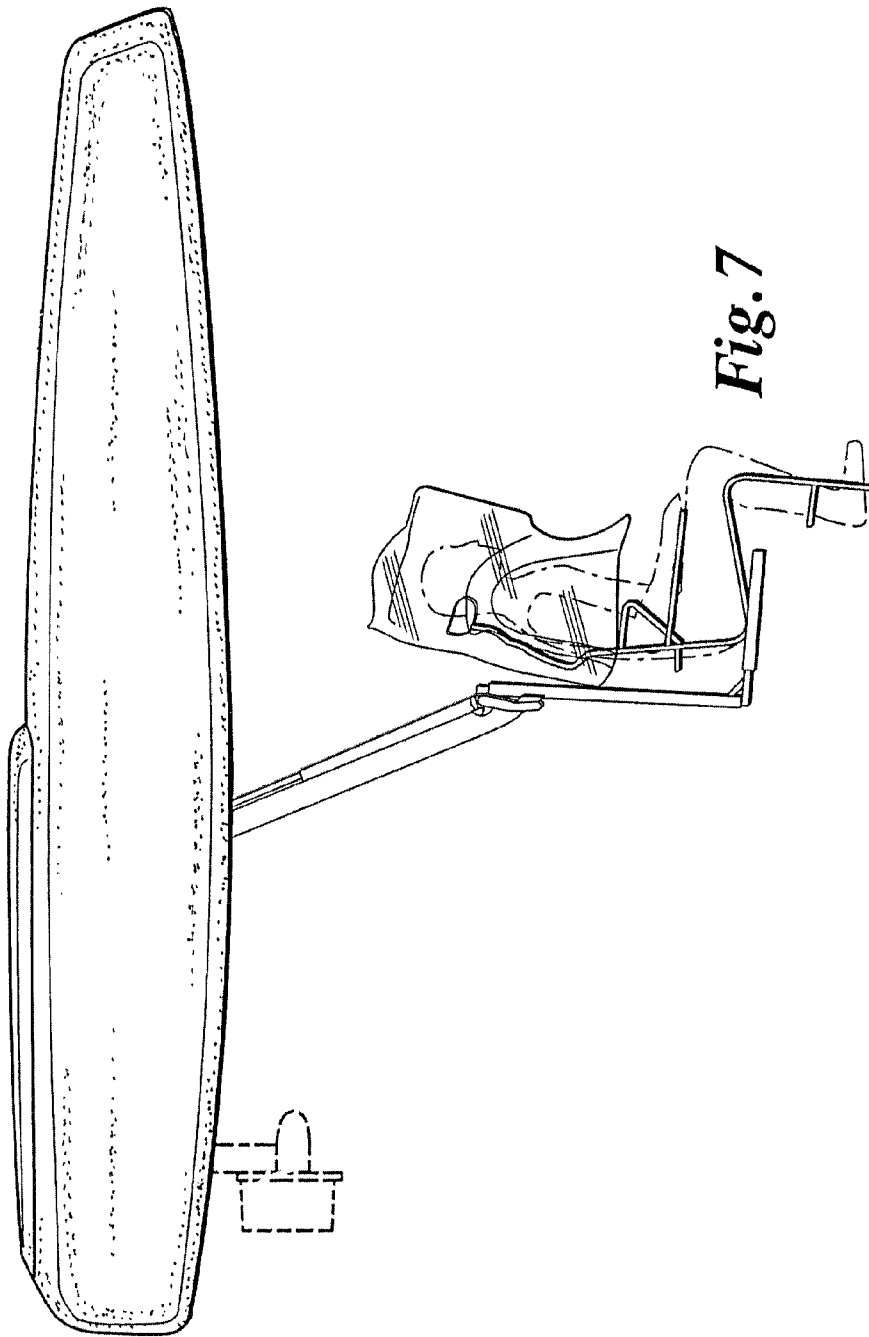

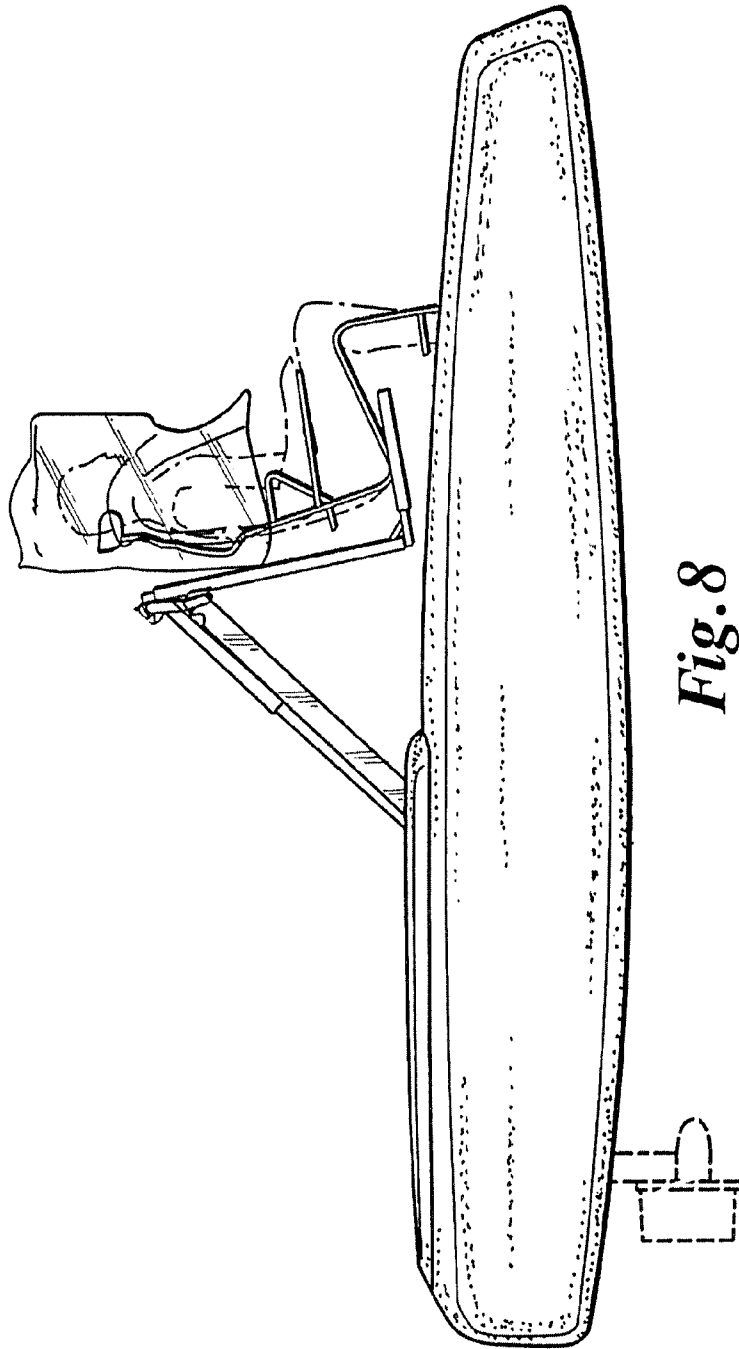
