

The ornamental design for an elbow coupling, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a first embodiment of our design for an elbow coupling;
FIG. 2 is a top view of the elbow coupling shown in FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a bottom view of the elbow coupling shown in FIG. 1;
FIG. 4 is a left side view of the elbow coupling shown in FIG. 1, the right side being shown in perspective in FIG. 1;
FIG. 5 is a front view of the elbow coupling shown in FIG. 1;
FIG. 6 is a rear view of the elbow coupling shown in FIG. 1;
FIG. 7 is a perspective view of a second embodiment of our design for an elbow coupling;
FIG. 8 is a top view of the elbow coupling shown in FIG. 7;
FIG. 9 is a bottom view of the elbow coupling shown in FIG. 7;
FIG. 10 is a left side view of the elbow coupling shown in FIG. 7, the right side being shown in perspective in FIG. 7;
FIG. 11 is a front view of the elbow coupling shown in FIG. 7; and,
FIG. 12 is a rear view of the elbow coupling shown in FIG. 7.
























