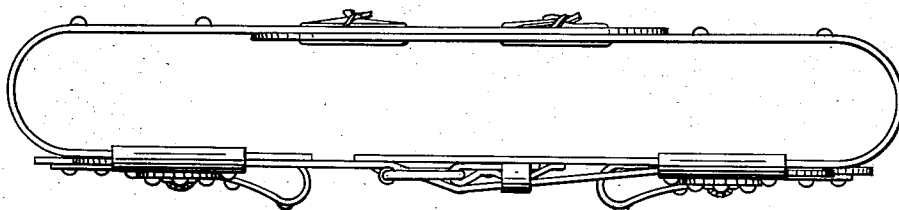
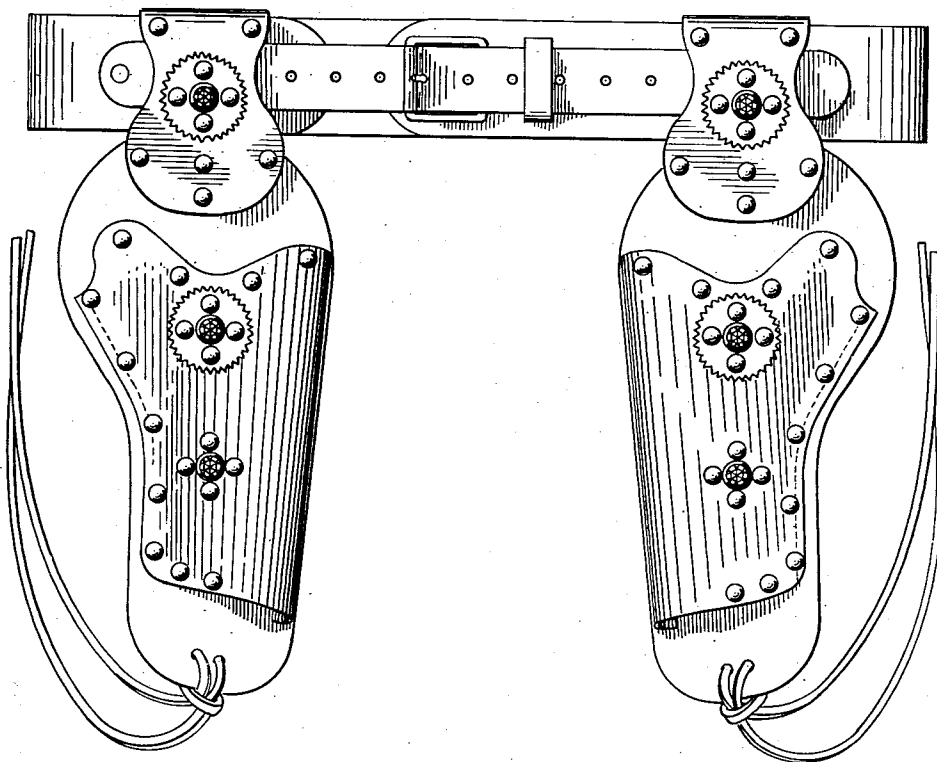

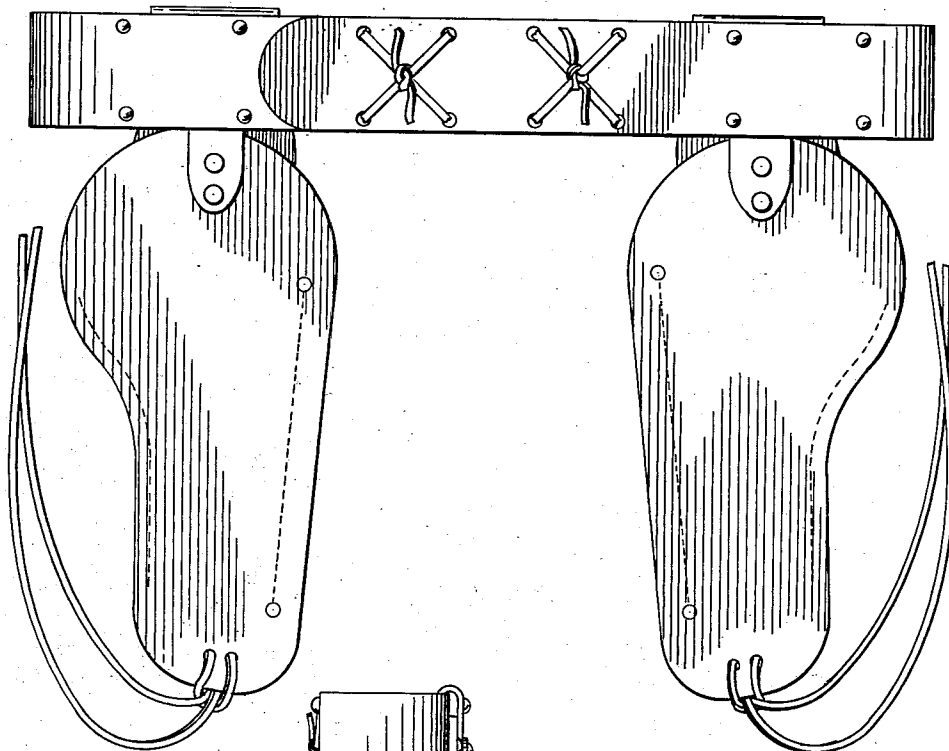
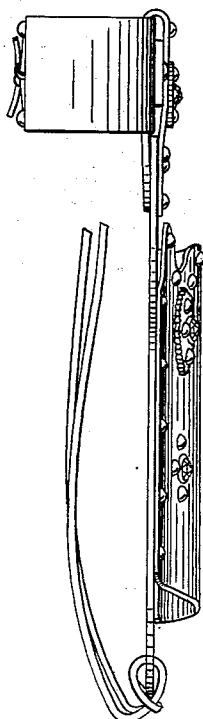

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Adam L. Kinskie, a citizen of the United States, residing at Morristown, in the county of Hamblen and State of Tennessee, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a combined Toy Holster and Belt Set, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, forming a part thereof.

Figure 1 is a top plan view of a combined toy holster and belt set, showing my new design;

Figure 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

Figure 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;

Figure 4 is a side elevational view thereof.
