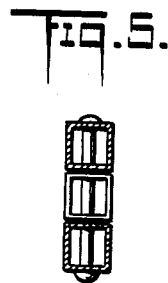
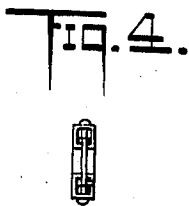
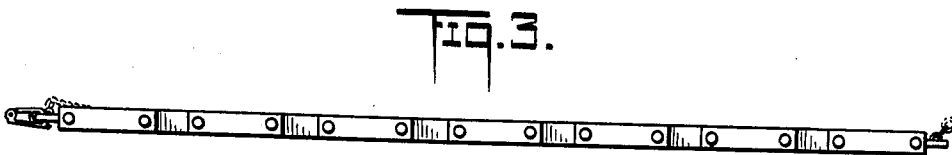
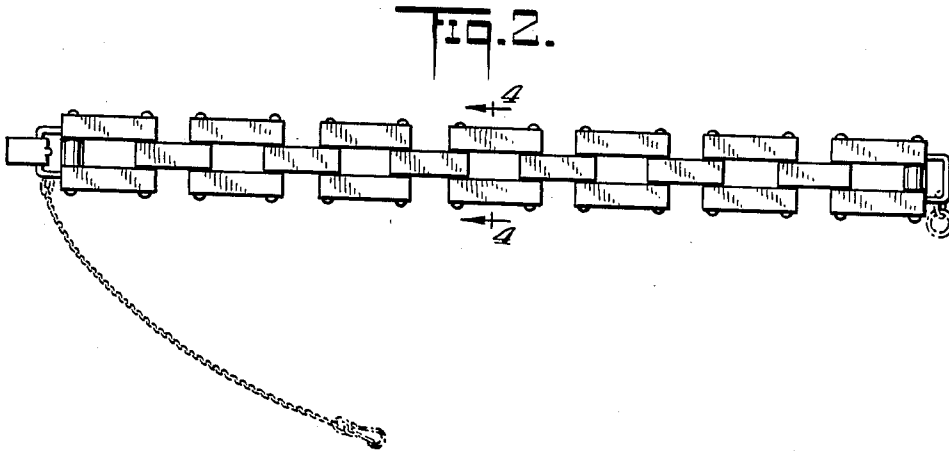
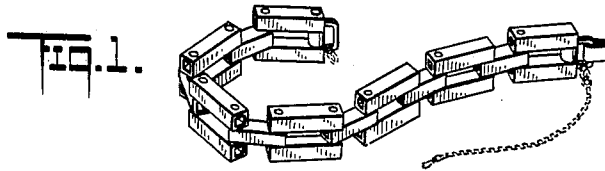

DESIGN FOR A BRACELET

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Michael Chernow, a citizen of the United States and residing at New York, in the county of New York and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Bracelet, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof, and in which:

Fig. 1 is a perspective view of the bracelet showing my new design,

Fig. 2 is a plan view of the bracelet,

Fig. 3 is a side elevation thereof,

Fig. 4 is an end view of the bracelet, and

Fig. 5 is a transverse sectional view on a larger scale taken on the line 4—4 of Fig. 2.

I claim:
