FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a motorcycle shock incorporating a design according to the invention.

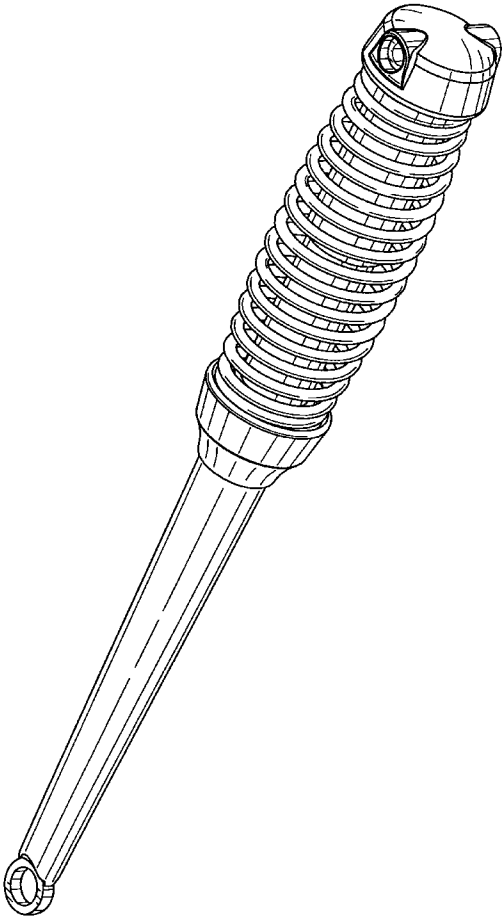
FIG. 2 is a left side view of the motorcycle shock of FIG. 1.

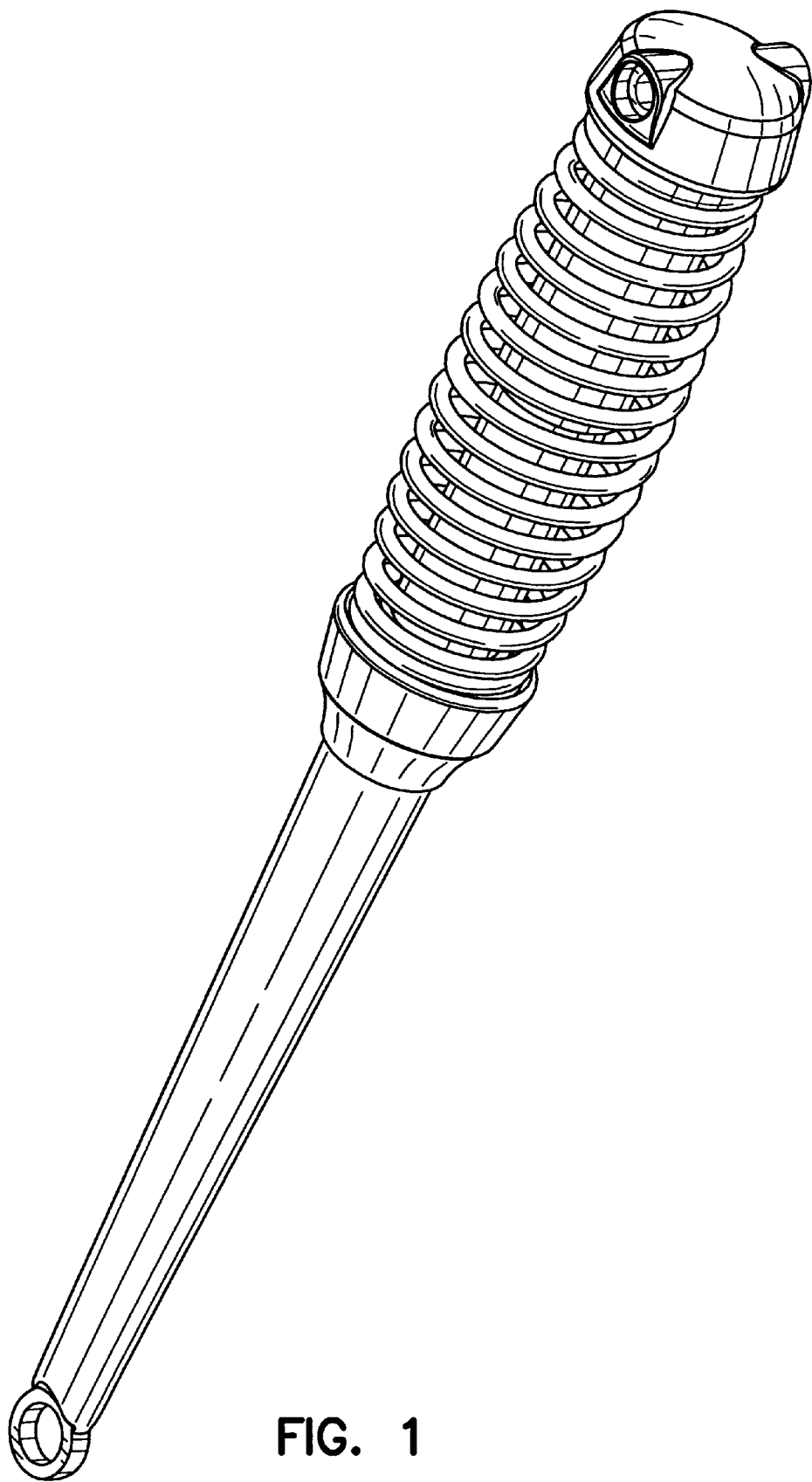

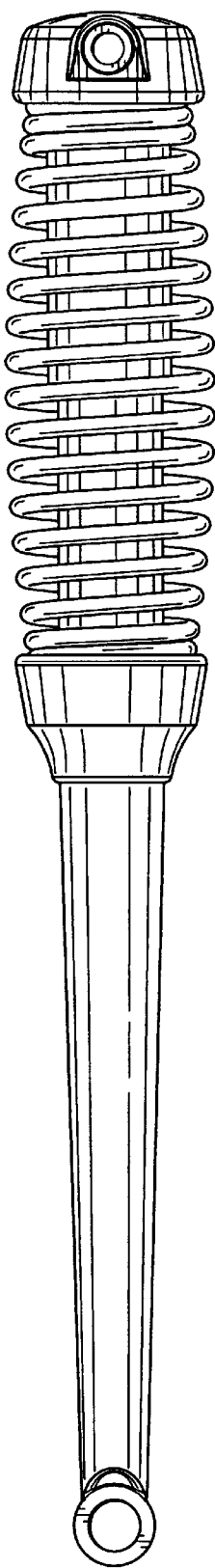

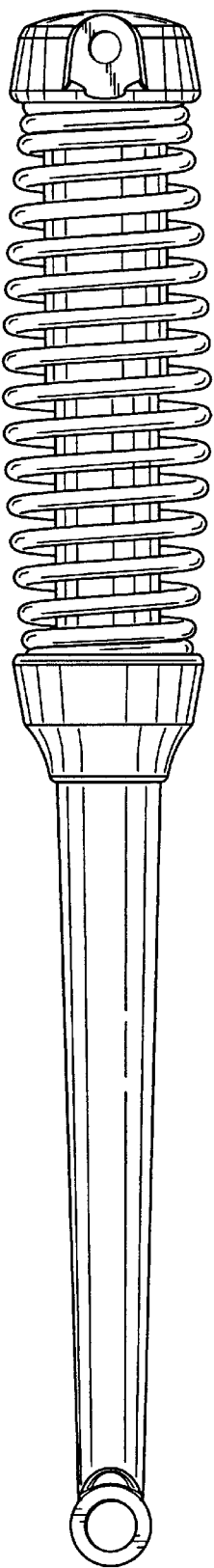

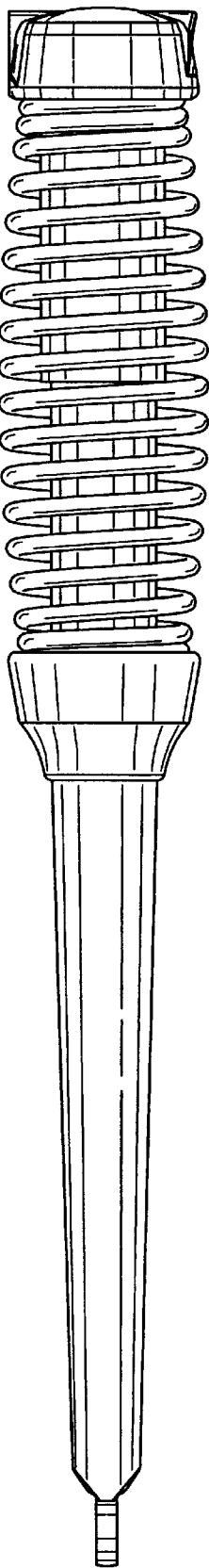

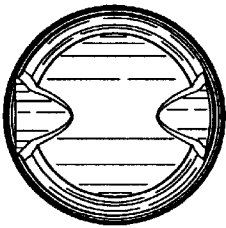

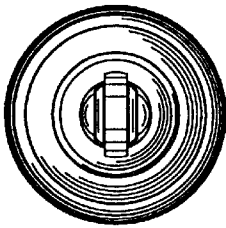
