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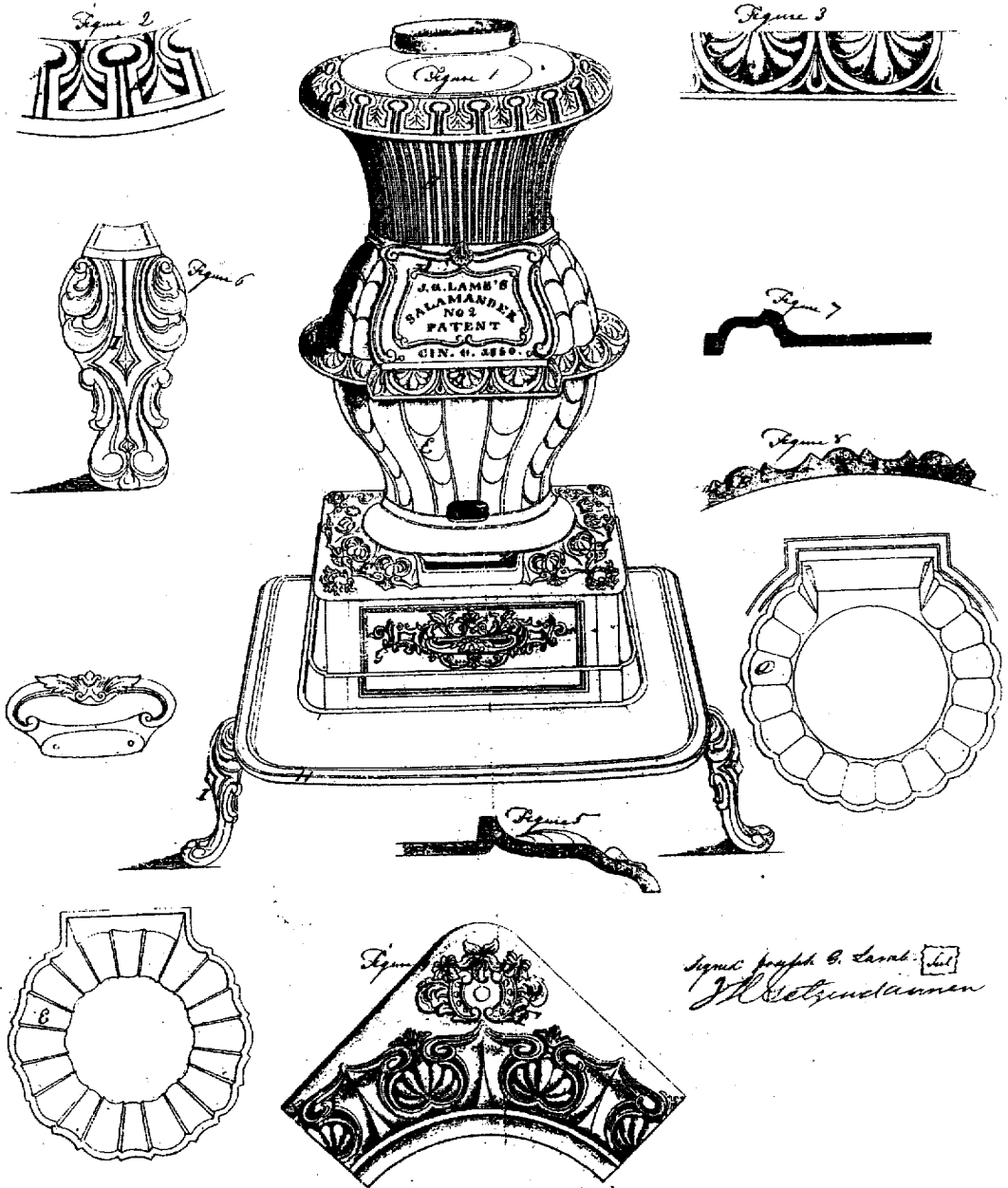

The schedule referred to in these Letters Patent and making part of the same

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that J. Joseph G. Lamb, of Cincinnati, in the County of Hamilton, and State of Ohio, have invented or produced a new Ornamental Design for Coal Heating Stoves; and I do hereby declare that the following is a full and exact description, and that the accompanying drawings a correct representation of the same.

To wit. Figure 1, is a perspective view of a complete stove. Figure 2, section of Top Moulding. Figure 3, section of Moulding and centre of Stove. Figure 4, Corner section of top of Base or Ash Box. Figure 5, cut view of Box top. Figure 6, Foot. - Figure 7, Moulding around bottom plate. Figure 8, section of Top barrel cut horizontally. - Letters A A, refer to corresponding parts. Letters B, C, F, I, H, also refer to corresponding parts. Letter D, middle barrel with convex flutes each one cut so as to represent scales lapsing, each other & pointing upwards. Letter E, Lower Barrel fluted with alternate convex & concave flutes, the convex ones scaled like middle barrel but pointing downwards. G, Front of Ash Box - J, Front Door.

What I claim as new and my invention,

is the arrangement and combination of the above described and represented shapes, Figures, ornaments, flutes & Mouldings into the above specified Design for Coal Heating Stoves, substantially as above shown.
