

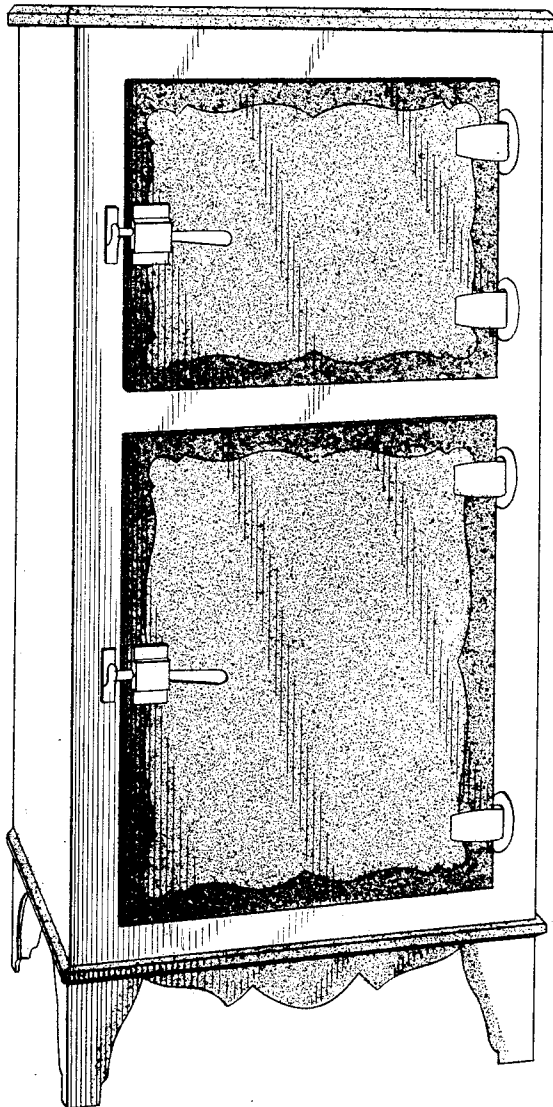

DESIGN FOR AN ICE BOX

Application filed May 5, 1932. Serial No. 43,721. Term of patent $3\frac{1}{2}$ years.

To all whom it may concern:
