

Each musical tone set in a predetermined sequence or concurrent arrangement is playable in turn and in response to an output actuation (160) of an actuator means of instrument section 1 at a timing determined by user according to a First method and a First process of actuation (160). Musical tones are actuated likewise when two or more First actuator means operable by one or more performers plays a concurrent number of predetermined sequences, simultaneously.
