DESIGN FOR A FOUNTAIN PEN

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Maurice J. Waldinger, a citizen of the United States of America, residing at Flushing, Long Island, in the county of Queens and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Fountain Pen, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Figure 1 is the side elevational view of a fountain pen showing my new design thereof, with the writing point covered by the cap.

Figure 2 is the back elevational view of the fountain pen with the cap removed.

Figure 3 is a side elevational view of the cap only.
