

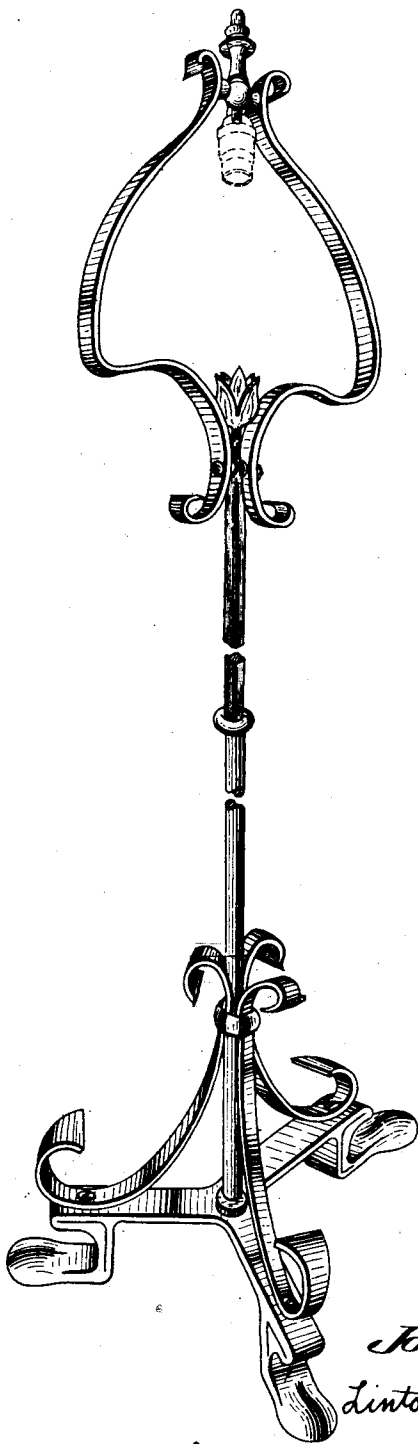

DESIGN FOR A BRIDGE LAMP

Application filed August 21, 1929. Serial No. 32,496. Term of patent 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ years.
