

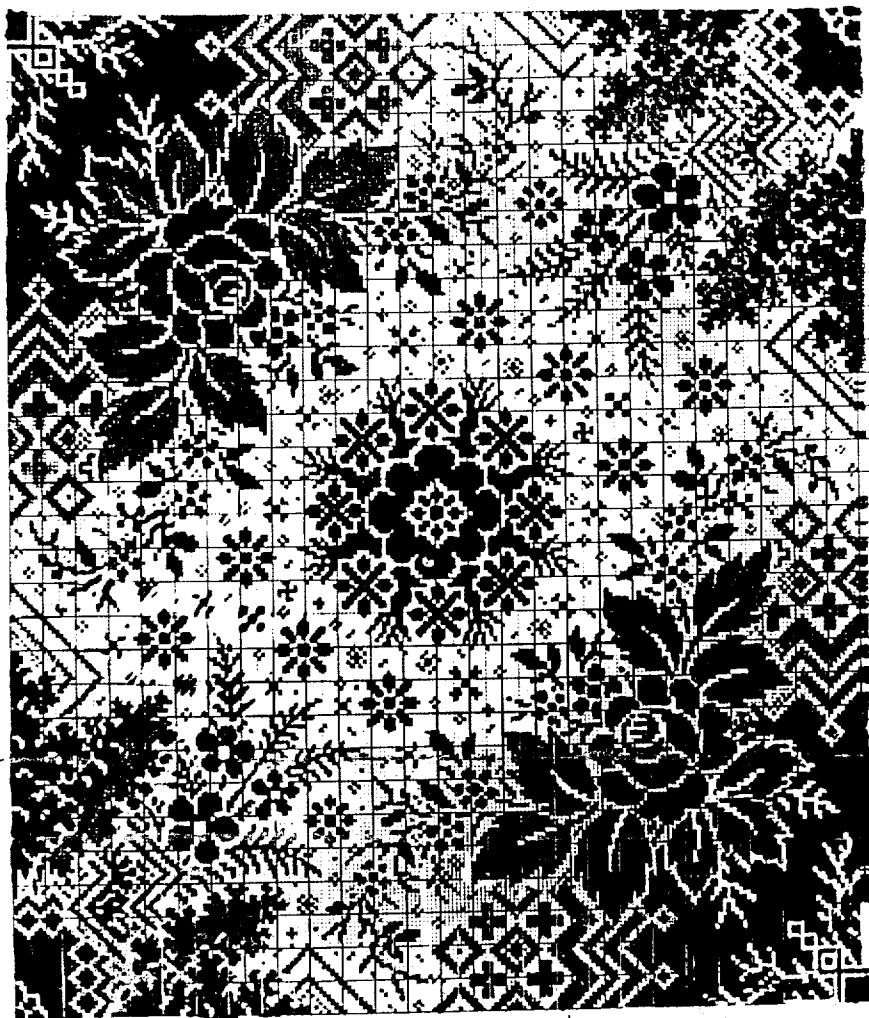

To all whom it may concern:

5 a new and original Design for a Pattern to be
Inwrought into Ingrain and other Carpeting;
and I do hereby declare that the photographic

10 of carpet-weaving a defined and thorough de-
scription of the nature of my invention, that is

sufficient to enable any one skilled in the art
of carpet-weaving to use my invention.
