

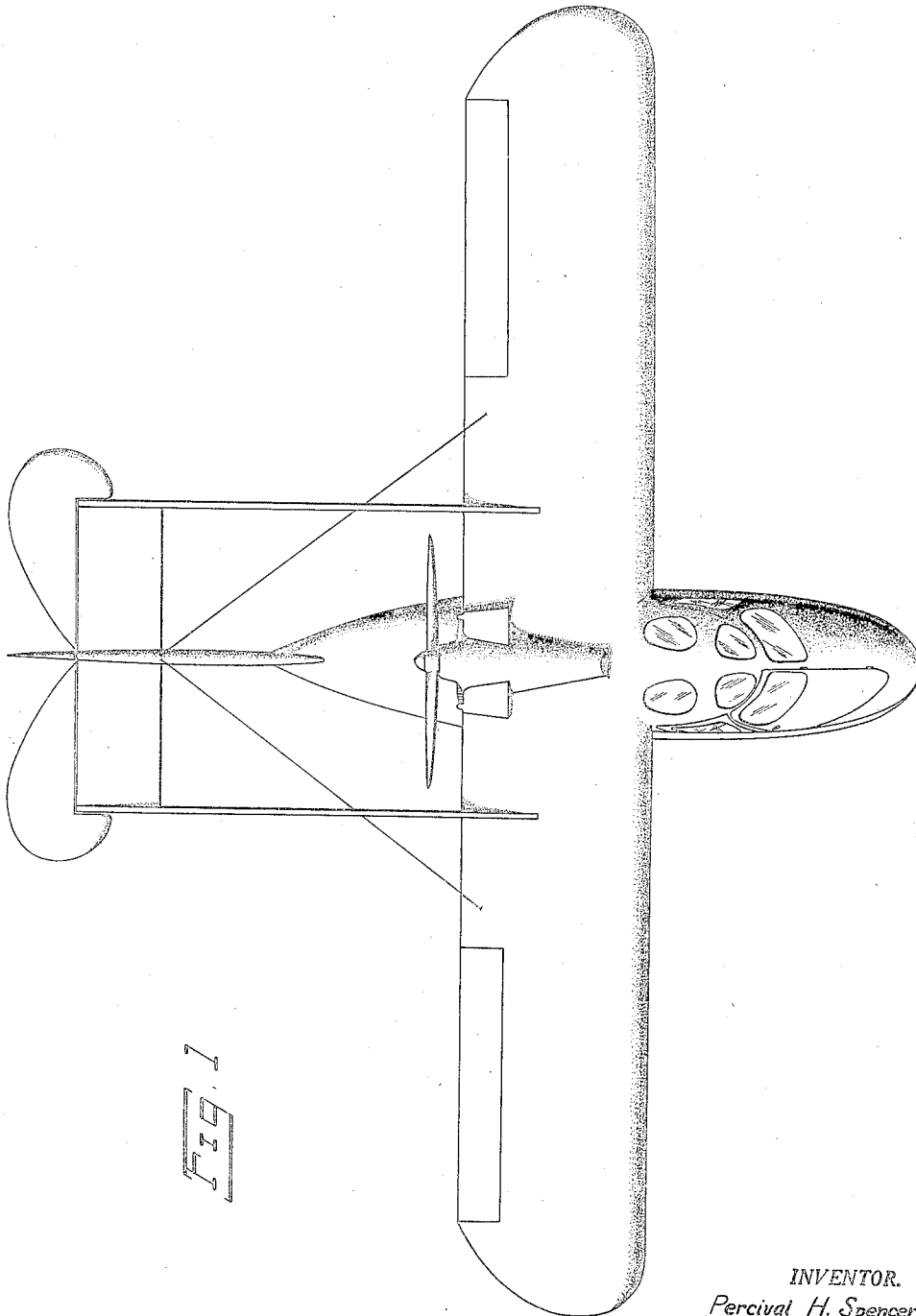

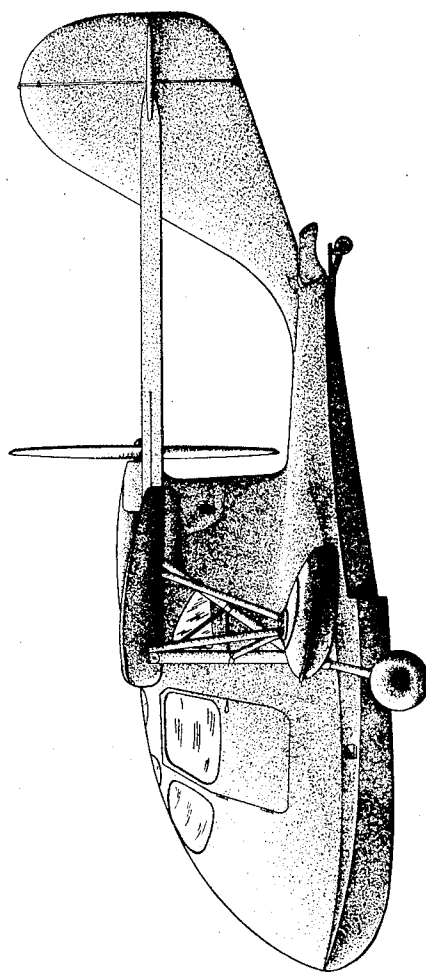
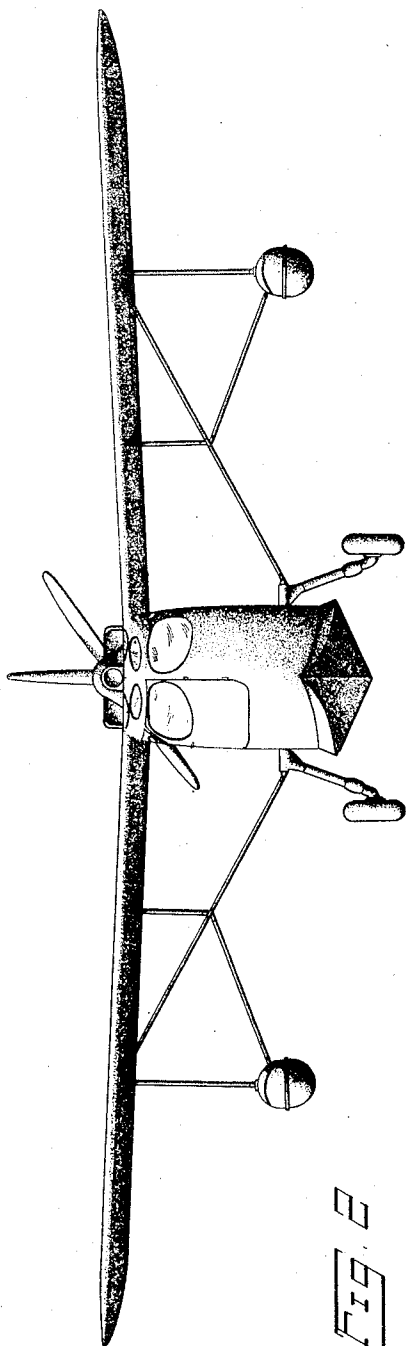

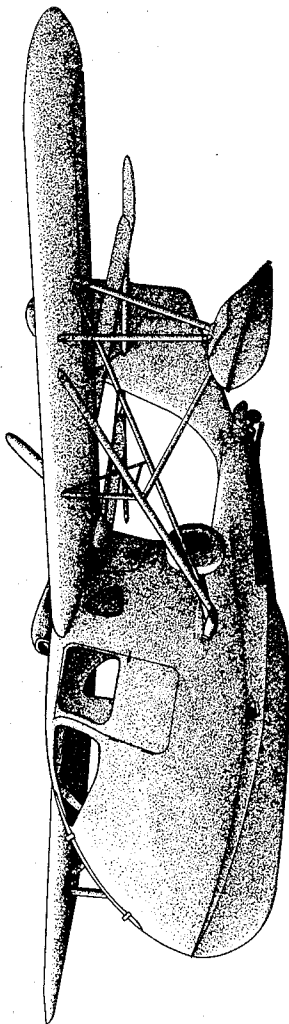

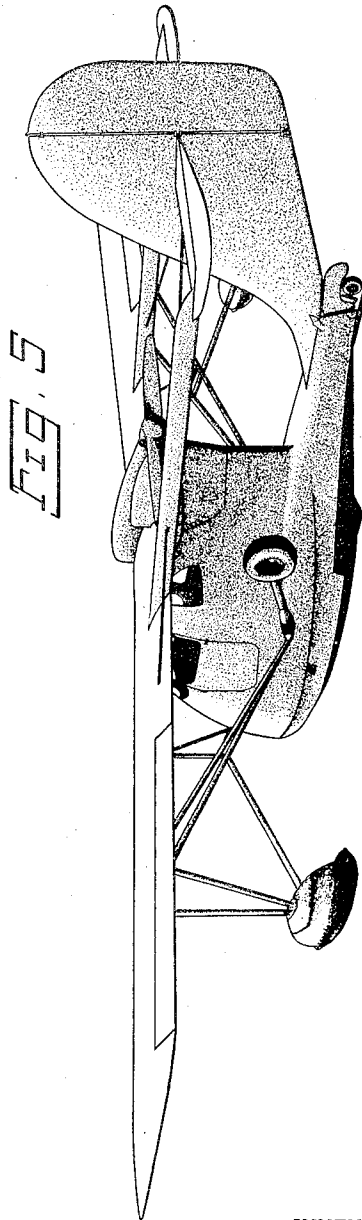

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that Percival H. Spencer, a citizen of the United States, and a resident of Babylon, New York, has invented a certain new, original, and ornamental Design for an Amphibian Airplane, as described in the following specification and shown in the accompanying drawings, wherein:

In the drawings,

Fig. 1 is a plan view of an airplane embodying the present design;

Fig. 2 is a front elevation thereof with the landing gear protracted;

Fig. 3 is a side elevation thereof with the landing gear protracted;

Fig. 4 is a perspective view from the front of the airplane with the landing gear retracted; and

Fig. 5 is a perspective view from the rear with the landing gear retracted.

What is claimed is:

The ornamental design for an amphibian airplane, substantially as shown.
