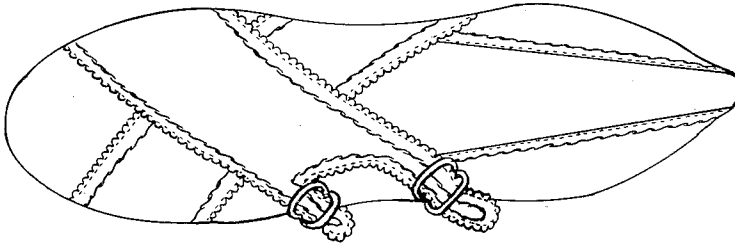

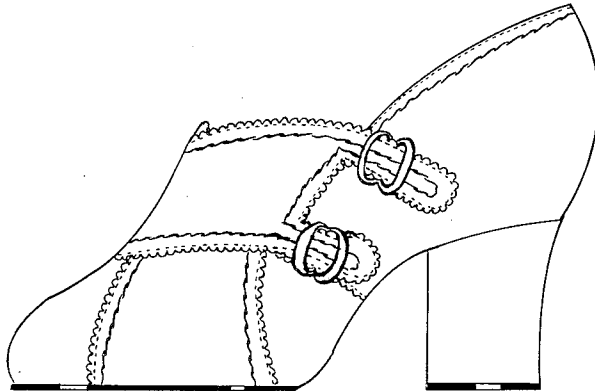

## DESIGN FOR A SHOE

*To all whom it may concern:*
