




DESIGN FOR A LENS OR SIMILAR ARTICLE

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, George M. Cressaty, a citizen of France, residing in New York, in the county and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Lens or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a top plan view of a lens or similar article showing my new design;

Fig. 2 is a side elevational view thereof partly in section as indicated on line 3—3 of Fig. 1; and

Fig. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof.
