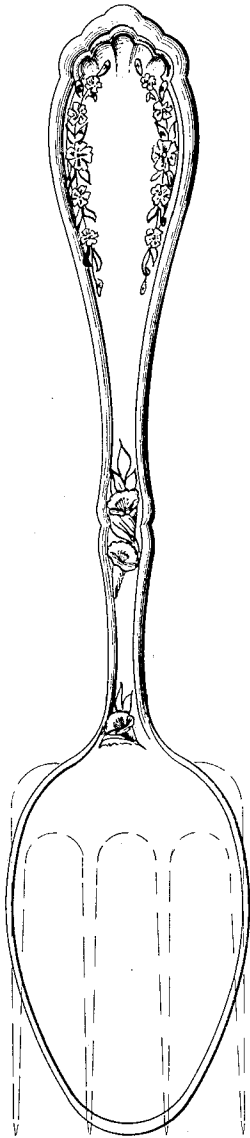

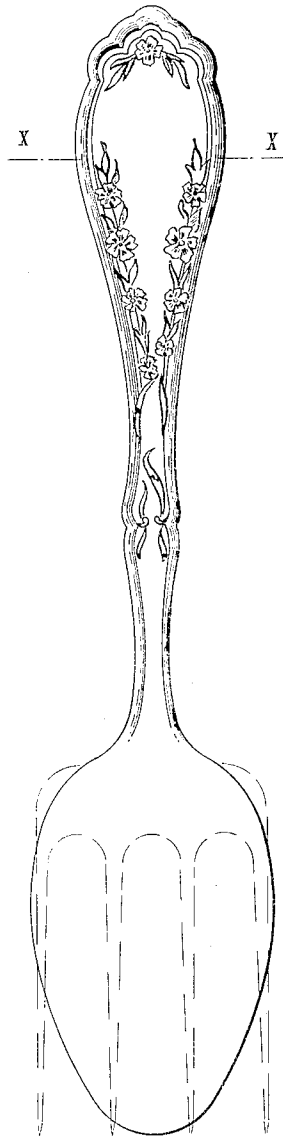

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, WILLIAM A. JAMESON, a citizen of the United States, residing at Niagara Falls, in the county of Niagara and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Handle for a Spoon, Fork, or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof, wherein—

Figure 1 represents an obverse view of a

handle for a spoon, fork, or similar article, showing my new design; Fig. 2, a reverse view; and Fig. 3, a section on line $x-x$ of Fig. 2.
