

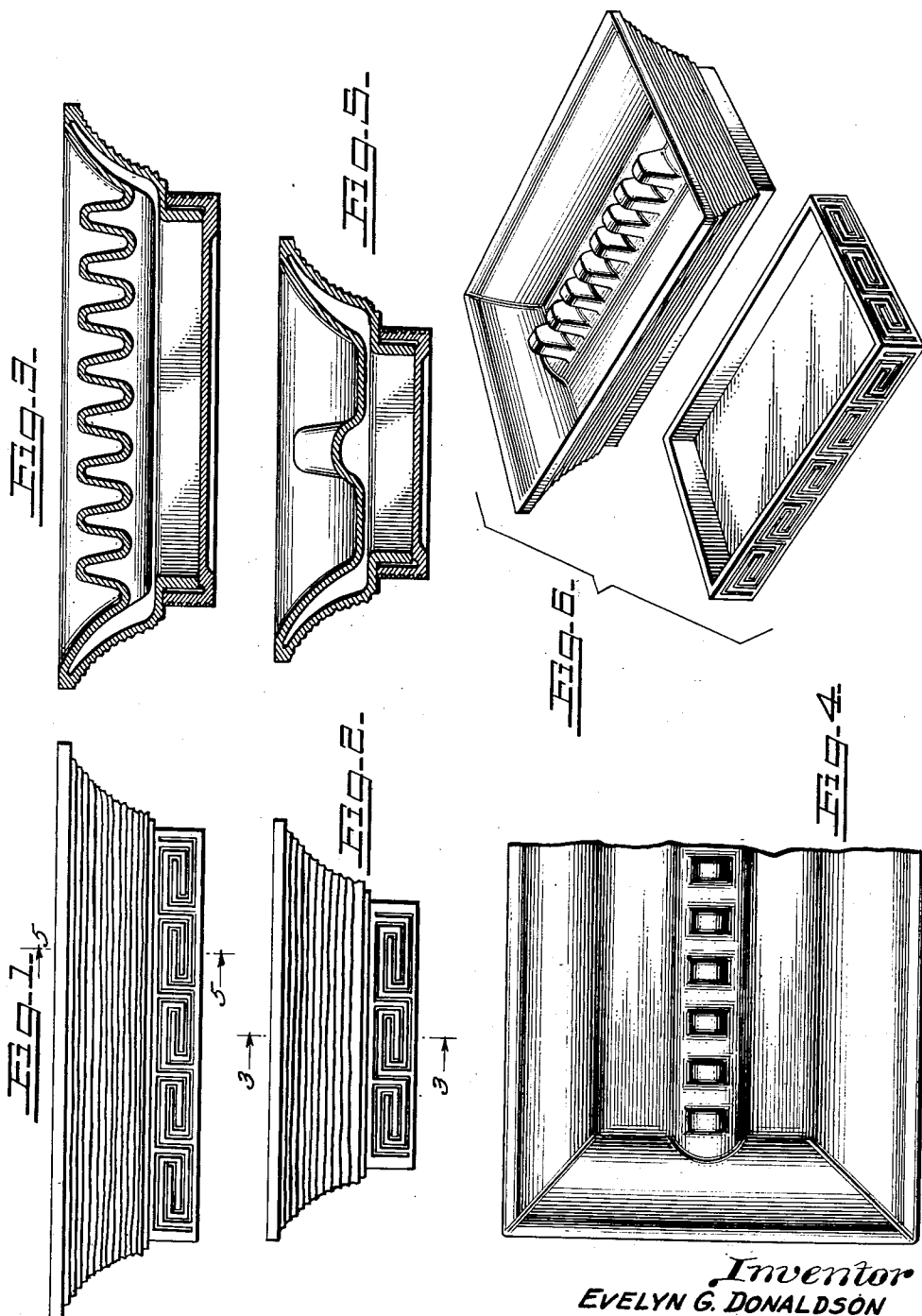

COMBINED ASH TRAY AND CIGARETTE CONTAINER

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Evelyn G. Donaldson, a citizen of the United States of America, residing at Denver, in the county of Denver and State of Colorado, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Combined Ash Tray and Cigarette Container, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part hereof.

In the drawing:

Fig. 1 is a side view of a combined ash tray and cigarette container, showing my new design. The opposite side is similar.

Fig. 2 is an end view thereof. The opposite end is similar.

Fig. 3 is a longitudinal section therethrough, taken on the line 3—3, Fig. 2.

Fig. 4 is a fragmentary plan view thereof, illustrating one extremity of the new design. The opposite extremity is similar.

Fig. 5 is a cross-section therethrough, taken on the line 5—5, Fig. 1; and

Fig. 6 is an exploded, perspective view illustrating the two component parts of the combined ash tray and cigarette container.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a combined ash tray and cigarette container, as shown and described.
