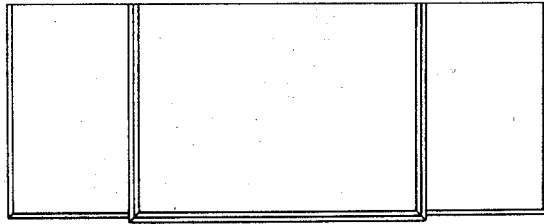

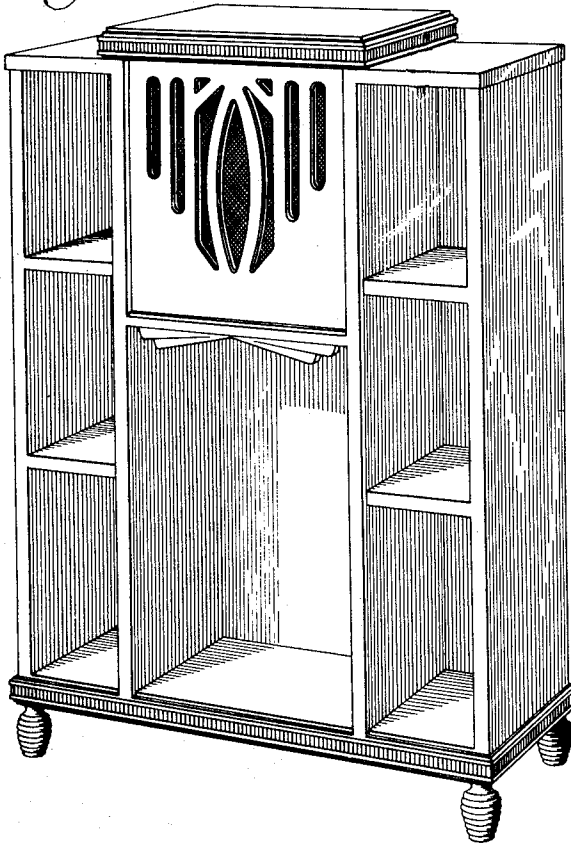
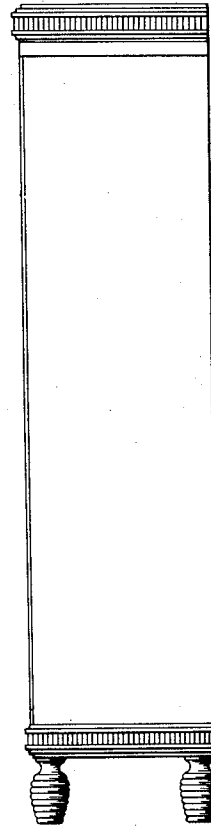

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, MARTIN HANSON, a citizen of the United States, residing at Chicago, in the county of Cook and State of Illinois, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Combination Radiocabinet and Bookcase, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof, and in which:

Fig. 1 is a top plan view of the article, showing my new design;

Fig. 2 is a perspective view of the same; and

Fig. 3 is a side elevational view thereof.
