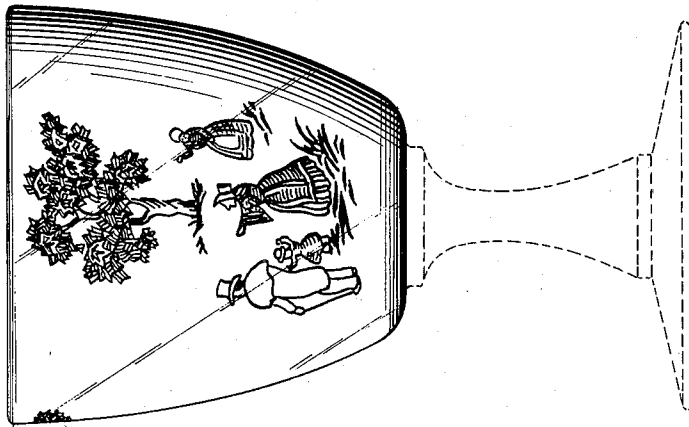

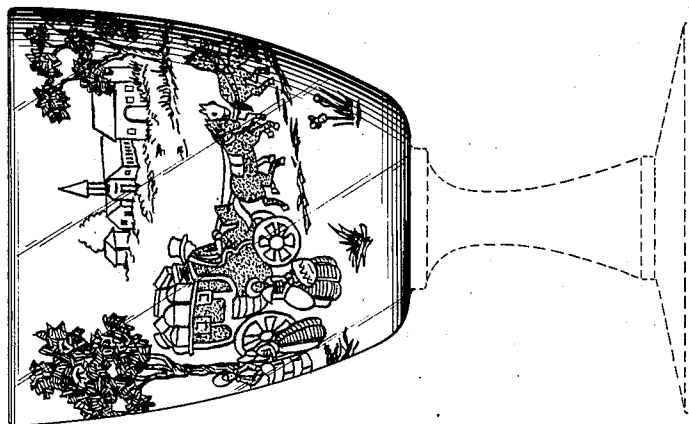
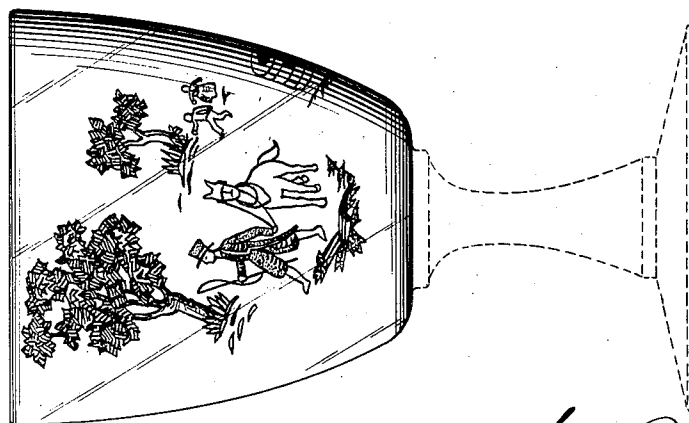

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Edgar Mott Bottome, a citizen of the United States of America, and resident of Moundsville, county of Marshall, and State of West Virginia have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Goblet or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof, in which—

Fig. 1 is a side elevational view of the goblet showing my new design;

Fig. 2 is a side elevational view of the goblet turned through 120° in relation to Fig. 1; and

Fig. 3 is a side elevational view of the goblet turned through 240° in relation to Fig. 1.

The dominant feature of my design resides in the portion shown by solid lines.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a goblet or similar article, substantially as shown and described.
