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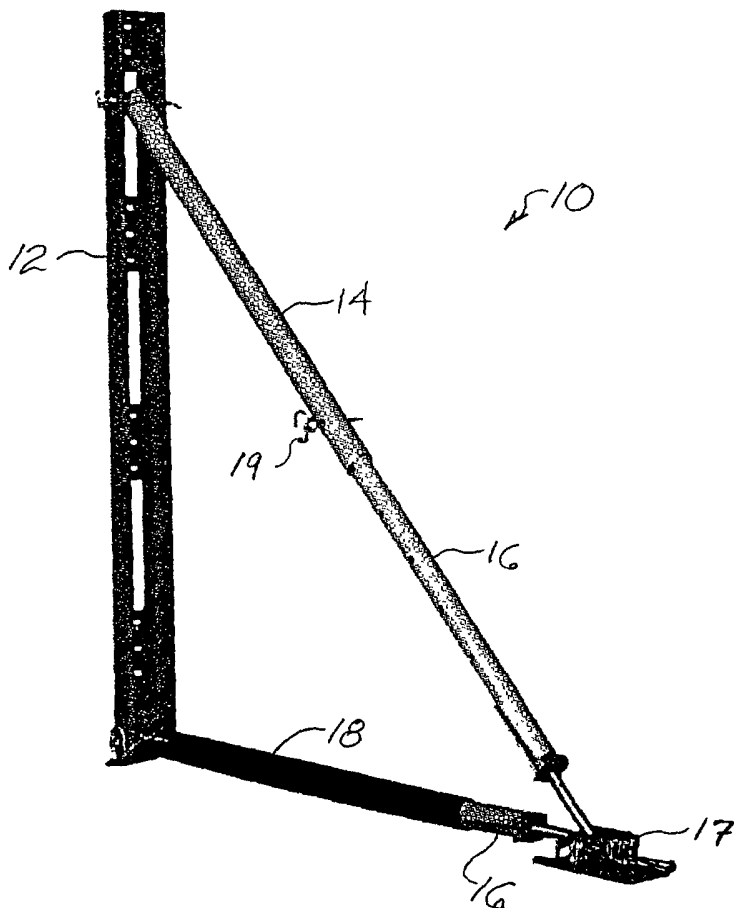

(54) Title: SHORING SYSTEM APPARATUS AND METHOD FOR SHORING



(57) **Abstract:** A shoring system (10) to support a vertical surface is provided. The shoring system (10) includes a main frame (12) including a first end and a second end and a first member (14) connected to the main frame near the first end. A first length adjuster (16) is disposed in the first member and a second member (18) is connected to the main frame near the second end. A second length adjuster (16) is disposed in the second member and the first length adjuster and the second length adjuster connect to a base plate (17). A method for shoring a vertical surface is also provided.
