


Be it known that I, CHARLES P. L. HUSTON, a citizen of the United States of America, residing in the town of Plainfield, in the county of Union and State of New Jersey, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Tire-Casings, of which the following description, in connection with the accompanying drawing, is a specification.

Figure 1 is a top plan view, and Fig. 2 is a cross-sectional view of a tire showing my new design.
