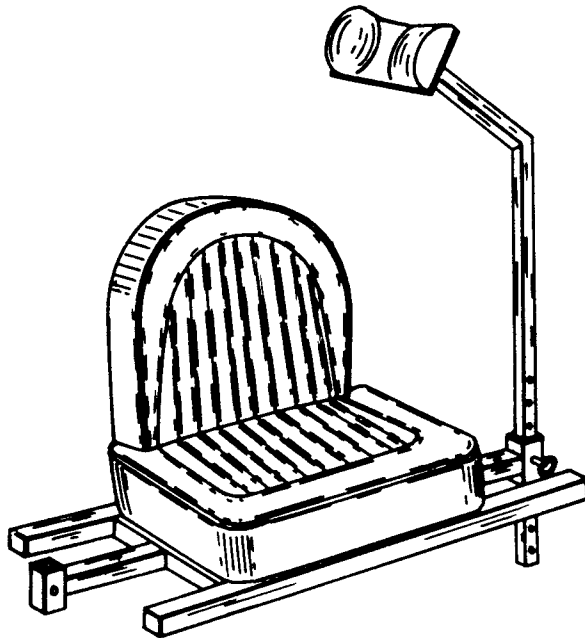

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a child's combined barberchair and adjustable cheekrest, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a first perspective view of my new design of a child's combined barberchair and adjustable cheekrest; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof.
The rear of the barber chair portion of this design is substantially plain.



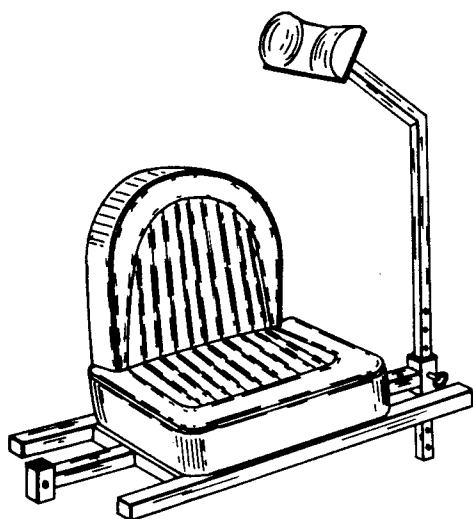

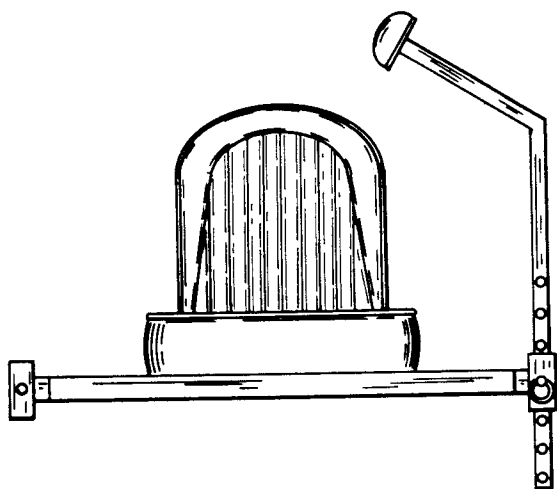

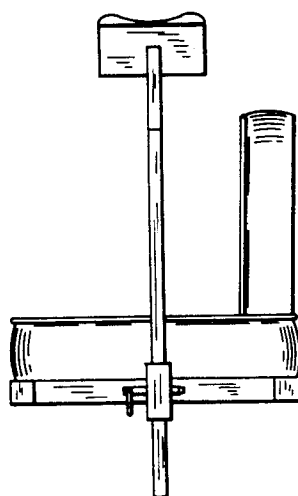

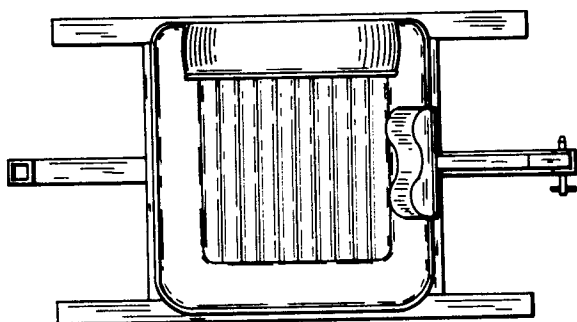
