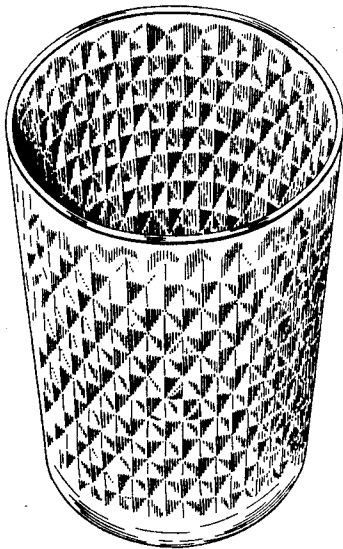

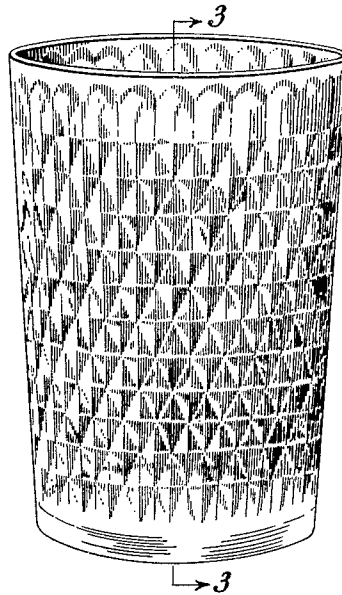

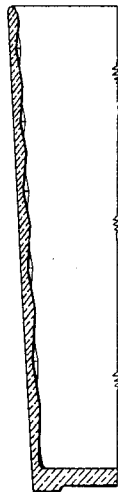

DESIGN FOR A GLASS TUMBLER OR ARTICLE OF SIMILAR NATURE

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, ROBERT J. BEATTY, a citizen of the United States, residing at Columbus, county of Franklin, Ohio, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Glass Tumbler or Article of Similar Nature, of which the following is the specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, forming a part hereof.

Figure 1 is a perspective view of a tumbler, showing my new design.

Figure 2 is a side elevation thereof.

Figure 3 is a sectional view taken on the line 3—3 of Figure 2.
