





## CHOCOLATE TEMPERING MILL UNIT

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, Robert E. Savage, a citizen of the United States, residing at Winnetka, in the county of Cook and State of Illinois, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Chocolate Tempering Mill Unit, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof, wherein—

Figure 1 is a perspective view of a chocolate tempering mill unit showing my new design, the two hidden sides of the structure being substantially duplicates of those which are illustrated;

Fig. 2 is an end elevational view thereof, and Fig. 3 is a top plan view thereof.

The dominant feature of my new design is disclosed in full lines.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a chocolate tempering mill unit, as shown and described.
