

### (54) Title: METHOD OF SUBSTITUTING CONTENT DURING PROGRAM BREAKS



(57) Abstract: A method of substituting content during a program break, includes: detecting a break in a broadcast program, and in response to the break, showing substitute content. A method of substituting broadcast content displayed on a screen, includes: determining an occurrence of a break in a broadcast content (520); and in response to the occurrence of the break, displaying substitute content on the screen (530). The method may further include: displaying the broadcast content when the break terminates (570).
