

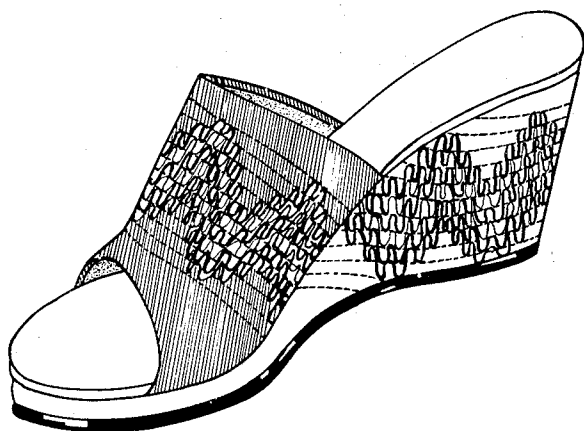

## DESIGN FOR A SLIPPER

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, Henry H. Gross, a citizen of the United States of America, residing in Brooklyn, county of Kings, and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Slipper, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

The figure is a perspective view of a slipper showing my new design, the opposite side having substantially the same appearance as the side shown.
