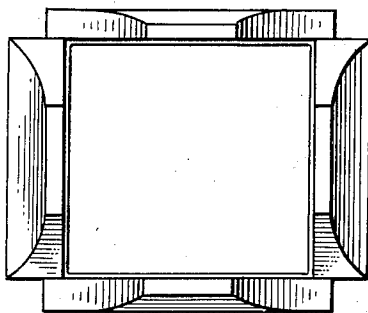

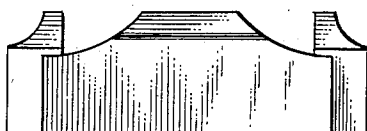
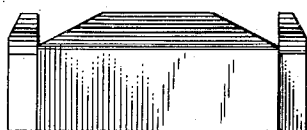

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Harry Dinhofer, a citizen of the United States of America and resident of the city, county, and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Watchcase Bezel, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof, in which:
