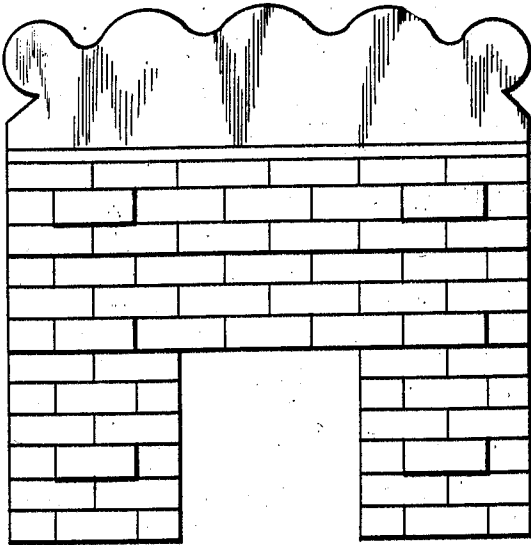

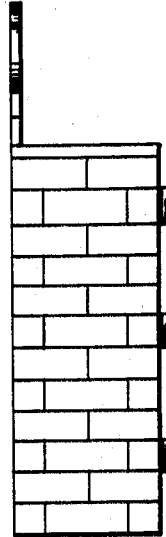
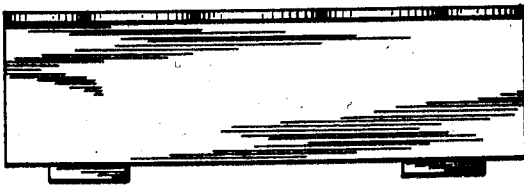

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Virgil G. Beauchamp, a citizen of the United States, residing at Chapin, in the county of Morgan and State of Illinois, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Buffet or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Figure 1 is a front elevational view of a buffet or similar article, showing my new design; Figure 2 is an end elevational view; and Figure 3 is a top plan view thereof.
