

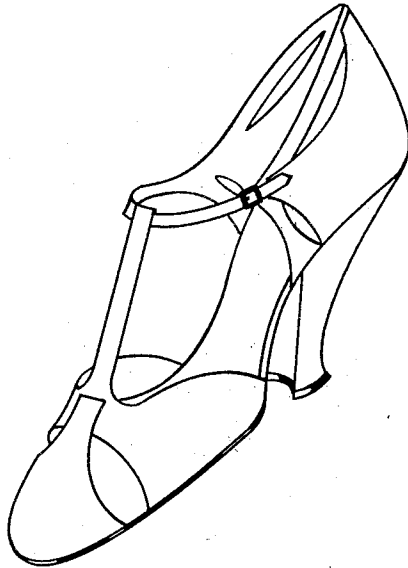

DESIGN FOR A SHOE

Application filed December 29, 1931. Serial No. 42,290. Term of patent 3½ years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, CHARLES MILLER, a citizen of the United States, and resident of the city of New York, county of New York, and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Shoe, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.
