



To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, James Morton McConnell, a citizen of the United States, residing at Chattanooga, in the county of Hamilton and State of Tennessee, have invented a new, original, and Ornamental Design for Picture Frames, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

Figure 1 is a plan view of a picture frame, showing my new design.

Fig. 2 is a horizontal sectional view of the picture frame shown in Fig. 1; and

Fig. 3 is a vertical sectional view of the picture frame shown in Fig. 1.
