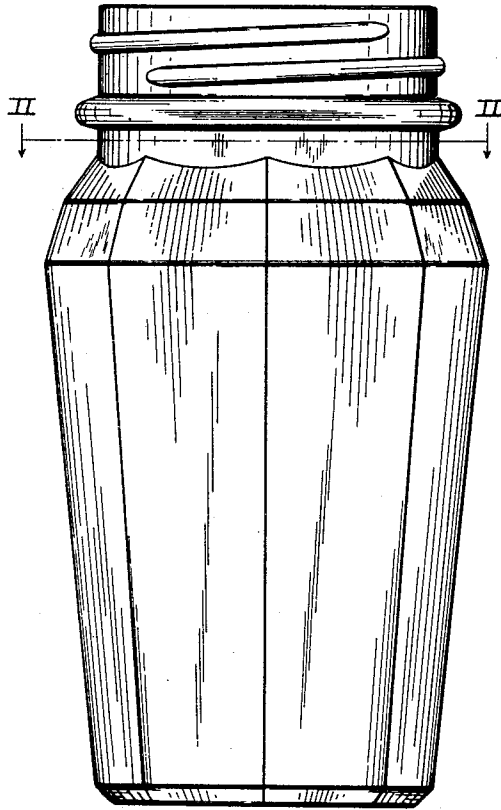

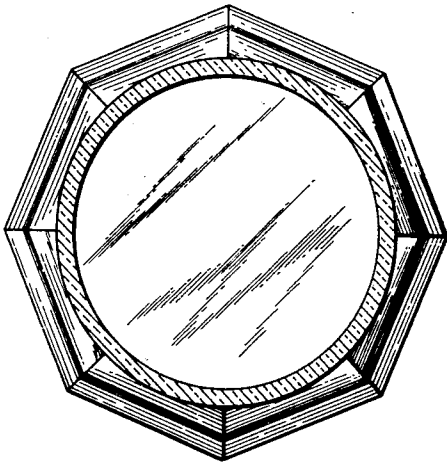
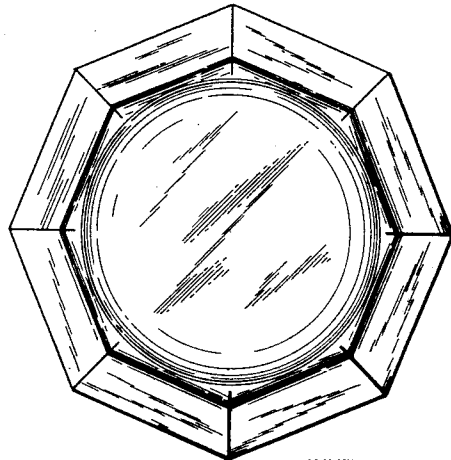

DESIGN FOR A JAR OR SIMILAR ARTICLE

Application filed April 14, 1932. Serial No. 43,492. Term of patent 7 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, OLBERT C. NOBLE, a citizen of the United States, residing at Washington, in the county of Washington, State of Pennsylvania, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Jar or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

Figure 1 is an elevational view of a jar or the like embodying my design; Fig. 2 is a sectional view taken on the line II—II of Fig. 1, and Fig. 3 is an inverted plan view thereof.
