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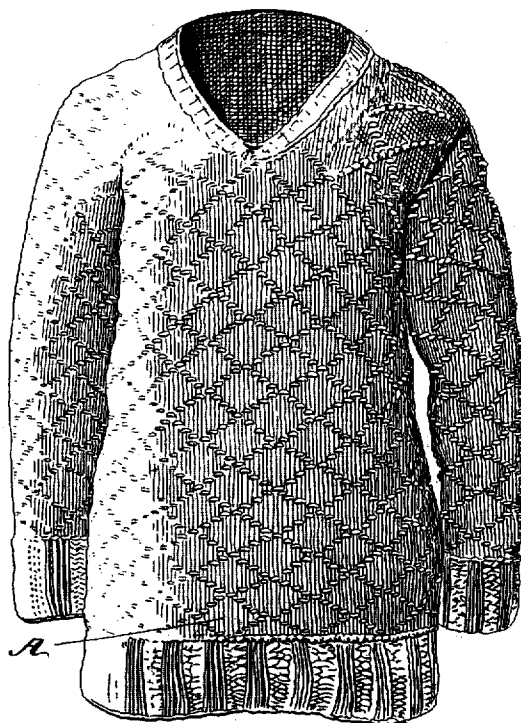

WILLIAM THOMAS PITCHERS, OF GODALMING, ENGLAND.

DESIGN FOR A SWEATER.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 22,878, dated November 7, 1893.

Application filed September 14, 1893. Serial No. 485,513. Term of patent 7 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, WILLIAM THOMAS PITCHERS, a subject of the Queen of Great Britain, residing at Godalming, England, have
5 invented and produced a new and original Design for a Sweater, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming apart of this
10 specification, which represents a front view of a sweater ornamented in accordance with my design.

The feature of the design consists of the

body A, comprising the decorative panels placed in close relation to each other, the shape of the panels simulating a diamond figure, 15 which figure comprises, approximately, a sunken body and an embossed margin.

I claim—

The design for a sweater consisting of the body A, substantially as shown.
