



### DESIGN FOR A RUG

Application filed November 10, 1930. Serial No. 37,600. Term of patent  $3\frac{1}{2}$  years.

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, GUSTAVE M. FAUSER, a citizen of the United States of America, residing at Ardsley on Hudson, in the county of Westchester and State of New York, have invented a certain new, original, and ornamental Design for a Rug, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part hereof.

The figure is a plan view of a section of a rug showing my new design, the illustrated body section of the rug bounded by the indicating lines  $a-a'$ ,  $b-b'$ ,  $c-c'$  and  $d-d'$ ,

being continuously repeated throughout the entire body of the rug, the illustrated border section of the rug bounded by the indicating lines  $a-a'$  and  $b-b'$  being continuously repeated throughout the border of the rug and the illustrated border corner bounded by the indicating lines  $a-a'$  and  $d-d'$  being repeated in proper relation in the other three corners of the rug.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a rug substantially as shown and described.
